On Wednesday, March 17, 2021, Ofc. J. Lopez and I, Ofc. Ane, were dispatched to 7 Higgs Lane, in reference to a trespasser.

Upon arrival, Ofc. J. Lopez and I met with the reporting party, Sean Willis. Willis advised his girlfriend, Ashley Coffin, needed to be removed from the home. In speaking to Willis, it was immediately apparent he was under the influence of alcohol. Willis had slurred speech and smelled strongly of an alcoholic beverage. Willis said he and Coffin had been in a relationship for a few months and she was in town visiting for the next few weeks, but needed to leave now, as they were fighting more.

Ofc. J. Lopez and I met with Coffin in a room located towards the front of the residence. Coffin explained she and Willis had been in a relationship for the last 17 years and she moved down here with Willis to 7 Higgs Lane a few weeks ago. Coffin explained over the last few weeks Willis has been drinking heavily and has become more violent towards. Coffin accused Willis of "Smacking" her with an open hand three days ago, but was afraid to call the police. Coffin showed us several photographs on her phone of her crying with an injury to her face.

Ofc. J. Lopez and I went back to Willis, who was seated on a porch on the north side of the residence. Ofc. J. Lopez asked Willis about the alleged battery. Willis denied all accusations. Ofc. J. Lopez asked for Willis' identification, to which he provided.

Willis began raising and lowering his hands and asking questions to find out whether or not he was being compliant. Willis then stood up. I gave Willis a lawful command to sit down as we were still conducting an investigation. Willis ignored my command and turned his back to me. Willis then asked if he was under arrest, while walking towards the residence's open door. I grabbed Willis' shorts, just above his belt line and pulled him towards me. Willis grabbed the doors' knobs and tensed his body, refusing to let go. I pulled Willis again and he let go of the door and fell from the porch to the ground.

Once on the ground, Ofc. J. Lopez and I placed Willis in handcuffs.

I called for Sgt. C. Sims to respond to our location to document my response to resistance.

After further investigation, it was determined there was no probable cause to arrest Willis for the alleged battery on Coffin. However, as Willis did refuse to comply with several lawful commands during the course of a criminal investigation, I placed him under arrest for resisting arrest without violence.

I transported Willis to MCDC without further incident.

This investigation was recorded via my department issued body worn camera, which I later uploaded to evidence.com.

On March 17, 2021 at approximately 2118 hours, Ofc. Ane and I, Ofc. Lopez were dispatched 7 Higgs Lane. The caller told Key West Dispatch he needed a female removed from the property. The caller asked the female to leave the property and the female refused.

Upon arrival, I met with the caller. The caller was later identified with his Colorado driver's license as Sean Willis, (dob:05/24/1987). Sean said his girlfriend is inside the house and she is refusing to leave the property. I told Sean to wait outside while Ofc. Ane and I interview the female near the driveway of the house.

Ofc. Ane and I spoke with the female and she was identified with her Colorado driver's license as Ashley Coffin, (dob:02/06/1987). Ashley told us Sean and herself traveled to Key West together. Ashley provided documentation indicating both of their names are on the lease agreement. Ashley told us Sean has an alcohol problem and when he drinks, he becomes aggressive towards her. Ashley told us she moved all her belonging into a separate room to avoid confrontation with Sean.

Ashley told us she has been dating Sean for approximately 17 years.

Ofc. Ane and I walked back to speak with Sean in an attempted to explain him his options regarding the rental agreement. Sean was seated on the front steps of the house. I told Sean to give me his driver's license and he said, "Do you have a warrant". Sean handed me his license and I performed a name check with Key West Dispatch.

Sean told Ofc. Ane he did not read him his rights and kept asking is he was under arrest. I was still waiting for a return on Sean's name. Sean stood up and walked towards the front door. Ofc. Ane instructed Sean to seat down and Sean disregarded Ofc. Ane's instructions. Ofc. Ane grabbed Sean's shirt and pulled Sean back as he was attempting to go inside the house. Sean continued pulling away by leaning his body forward towards the front door. I grabbed Sean's right arm and escorted Sean to the ground with Ofc. Ane's assistance. I placed handcuffs on Sean.

I smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Sean's body.

Sgt. Sims arrived at the scene shortly after and spoke with Sean.
