START OF REPORT

On 01/16/21, at approximately 1440HRS, I (Ofc. B. DeHanas) was on an assigned detail to enforce Key West City Ordinance 21-20 (city ordinance). I was stationed in the 700 block of Duval Street.

INCIDENT

This incident involves Paul Kenneth Bennett. Paul violated city ordinance by not wearing his facial covering as I had asked him to do. Paul subsequently resisted my efforts to investigate.

I asked Paul several times to put his facial covering on. He repeatedly refused to comply with my order. I could tell that Paul was becoming more aggravated by his actions (he was pointing out other individuals who were not wearing their masks and continued to disregard my request that he put his facial covering on). I told Paul to put his mask on. Paul still did not comply with my lawful order. I repeatedly asked Paul to "please" put his mask on. I told Paul I would issue him a citation if he did not put his facial covering on. I continued to tell Paul to put his facial covering on and that he could take it off when he was away from me.

Paul folded his mask up and attempted to cover his nose and mouth (without actually putting the facial covering on). I asked him to put his mask on the "whole way". MOV 21-01 states to follow CDC guidelines for the proper wearing of a mask. The CDC website provides a video that describes to properly wear a mask by securing the mask under the chin and if the mask has loops to put those loops around your ears. Paul was not complying with CDC guidelines. Paul started to walk away from me without me telling him to do so. Paul took the facial covering away from his face and told me his facial covering was on. I told him to put the mask "all the way on". Paul put the facial covering over his nose and mouth again (without putting it all the way on as I asked). Paul started talking to me about a mental health condition of his. I asked him to follow me to my car multiple times. Paul refused to walk to my car and then walked away from me without me asking him to. Paul put his facial covering on as I asked him to. I told Paul that was all I was asking him to do.

Paul took his mask off again while he was still in my presence. I started to walk toward him and said "sir" in order to get his attention. Paul continued to walk away from me. This was when I decided I was going to place Paul under arrest for resisting my attempts to investigate and gain voluntary compliance with city ordinance. I got my handcuffs out and went to secure Paul with them. I told Paul to put his hands behind his back (as he was actively taking his mask off again). Paul jerked and pulled away from me hard. I told Paul not to resist. I told Paul to put his hand behind his back multiple times and Paul failed to comply with my order. I told Paul he was going to Jail and that I was going to deploy my TASER device on him. Paul continued to refuse my lawful orders to place his hands behind his back. I told Paul I did not want to deploy my TASER device on him. Paul started to point out other individuals who were not wearing their mask as I was dealing with him. Paul continued to pull away from me without giving me his right arm to properly concern him. I contemplated releasing Paul but decided not to give the actions he was displaying toward me. All the while I was repeatedly asking him to put his hands behind his back. Other officers responded. I repeatedly asked Paul to put his hands behind his back. Paul refused all of our lawful orders for him to place his hands behind his back.

Paul started to scream and ask why he was under arrest. I told Paul I was going to drive stun him (deploy my TASER device on him without using the prongs). Paul refused to put his hands behind his back. I drive stunned Paul without using the full cycle. Paul slummed to the ground. Paul continued to yell and scream. I was ultimately able to

secure Paul by placing handcuffs in the front of him. Ofc. Stevens requested a supervisor and I requested an ambulance to respond. I explained to Paul that we do not enjoy doing this.

Sgt. Siracuse responded as well as rescue personnel. I explained the situation to Sgt. Siracuse.

After speaking with Sgt. Siracuse, I decided not to arrest Paul for resisting due to the fact that he may have been experiencing a mental health issue during this incident (ticking, social anxiety issues) and did not attempt (intend) to commit any criminal act. I used my discretion in this incident to only issue a civil citation for failing to follow city ordinance.

Paul did not receive any further medical care and stated he was not injured.

I issued Paul a civil citation for violating city ordinance. Paul understood what he was signing and signed the citation.

On Saturday, January 16, 2021 I (Ofc. M. Calvert) was assigned to work on Duval St for the COVID Detail, asking citizens and visitors to comply with the city mask mandate.

At 1444 hours Ofc. Dehanas, also on the detail, called over the radio that he was with a non compliant subject at Pentronia St and Duval St and needed assistance. I was near my vehicle at Eaton St and Duval St at the time, and drove to assist Officer Dehanas. I arrived on scene and within a minute, Ofc. Stevens also arrived. I observed Ofc. Dehanas holding the male's left arm with a handcuff attached and asking for compliance to place his hands behind his back. The male, later identified by his Washington driver's license as Paul Bennett, was yelling loudly and not complying with Ofc. Dehana's lawful verbal orders. I placed my hands and Bennett's right arm and he braced and tensed, still refusing to put his hands behind his back. I held onto his arm and Ofc. Steven's grabbed the other arm when he arrived, Ofc. Dehanas stepped back and stated he for Bennett to comply or he would be drive stunned with the Taser. Bennett continued to scream, drawing a crowd around us, and brace and tense his arms so they could not be moved. Ofc. Dehanas drive stunned Bennett and he went to the ground, assisted, and the he was cuffed by Ofc. Dehanas in the front at that moment to secure him.

Bennett sustained minor scrapes to his left arm and left shin and a slight red mark on the lower back from the Taser. Sgt. Siracuse was called to the scene and Rescue 2 came to check Bennett. Sgt. Siracuse took photos of Bennett for the RRI.

Bennett disclosed he had medical conditions that were aggravated by the wearing of the mask, and these conditions were confirmed by a friend who was present with him.

After discussion between Sgt. Siracuse and Ofc. Dehanas, Bennett was released with a citation issued by Ofc. Dehanas. I removed the handcuffs from Bennett and he was compliant after that point.

My BWC was activated.

Nothing further.
