On April 6th, 2021, at approximately 0204 hours, I (Officer Deese) was dispatched to 1321 Simonton Street (Southwind's Motel) to assist in removing a subject off the property.

Upon arrival, Ofc. R. Perez, Ofc. M. Hansell and I made contact with Evan, the motel receptionist, who stated a female had locked a male out of her room. Evan stated she also told him that she didn't want him to stay on the property because she was scared of him and that he was a strange man. Evan stated she had told him "he is going to kill me".

Officers made contact with the male half, Craig Fluty (DOB 9/12/1973), who stated he was going to rent a separate room for the night. Craig stated, "I came home, and the door was locked. I tried opening it, she yelled, and they put me in here". Craig pointed to an empty room that Evan had stated he placed him in the for time being.

At this time, I informed the other officers on scene that I was going to try and make contact with the female in room 25. As I approached the door, I noticed the light was on in the bedroom. I knocked on the door and announced myself as Key West Police Department. The woman refused to open the door. Evan knocked on the window of the room. I heard a female voice yell, "what are you doing". Evan informed her that police were on the property and that we would like to speak with her. The female responded and said she was trying to sleep. Evan explained that he understood, and that he was trying to remove the male from the property due to her requesting it but that we needed to collect his belongings.

Ofc. M. Hansell arrived at the door of the unit and informed her that if she did not open the door and comply, the motel would evict her. He commanded her to open the door again. She refused to open the door. Ofc. M. Hansell then informed her that she would be arrested for theft because she would not return Craig's belongings to him. The female began yelling, "are you fucking kidding me" repeatedly. Ofc. M. Hansell informed her to open the door so we could collect his belongings. Ofc. M. Hansell informed her that the male had a backpack in the bedroom that we needed to retrieve. The woman refused to open the door. At this time, I knocked on the door loudly and commanded the female to open the door. The female continued to scream "are you fucking kidding me" and stated, "let me put some clothes on...".

Once the female opened the door, she threw a black suitcase out and struck my right leg with it. The female then turned around, walked back into the room and grabbed a backpack. The woman began to swing the backpack backwards to gain momentum to swing in forward toward me. I was able to grab the backpack from her hands and prevent her from hitting me with it.

At this time, the female stated, "this guy is coming in to fucking attack me, it is my room, I am paying for this room and this guy is coming in and I am getting arrested". I informed the woman that she was not getting arrested at this time and I asked her what had happened tonight. The woman would not tell me. I asked the female if Craig had a cell phone on him or if he had left it in the room. From the threshold of the door, I witnessed a black watch on the nightstand sitting next to a cell phone. I asked her if it belonged to him, and if she could grab it for me. She stated, "yeah, sure" and proceeded to walk over towards it. She stated, "I want nothing to do with him, I am trying to get his things". The woman started to talk louder but would not grab his watch. I asked her again to hand me his watch. She responded and said, "don't yell at me". I asked her again to hand it to me. She would not. At this time, I walked into the room, and retrieved the watch off of the nightstand. I walked back out of the room due to the female being extremely loud, to contact Ofc. R. Perez over the radio. I asked Ofc. R. Perez if Craig was missing anything else out of the room. Ofc. R. Perez informed me that he was missing his phone charger. While I was conversing on the radio,

the female continued to argue with the other officers on scene and stated "I am the fucking victim in this and you're a woman" while pointing to me. At this time, I asked her for the phone charger that she was holding as it belonged to him. She said "sure" and handed it to me. As I had turned to leave the area, I realized that the charger was missing the part that plugs into an outlet. I asked the female for the wall plug as I walked back up to the door. Her demeanor immediately changed, and she screamed, "no, get a warrant, get a fucking warrant".

At this time, the female tried to shut the door. I placed my hand on the door preventing her from shutting it. The female then grabbed my left arm and tried to remove it from the door. I immediately pushed her away from me and told her not to touch me. The woman straightened her back up took a step toward me and began screaming "don't ever touch me or I am calling the police" with her finger in my face. She began to scream "get out of here". The female continued to close the gap between us. I had to physically push her to create distance. In one swift motion, the female straightened her back and moved toward me, closing the gap again and pushed me in my chest. I took a couple steps back due to the impact. Once I was able to regain my balance, I went to reach for the female to gain control of her. The female then used her arm to wrap it around the back of my neck. She began to tighten her grip around my neck; however, I did not lose consciousness and did not struggle to breathe. I was able to grab the female in the same manor and attempt to take her down. The female continued to resist and would not let go of me. Both the female and I fell face down onto the front wooden patio which was directly off of the door to the room. I was able to position myself on top of the female, while repeatedly telling her to let go of me. I had to use my left forearm to pin the females head to the ground to get her to stop fighting. At this time, Ofc. M. Hansell arrived and assisted in removing me from the females grasp. Once she released her grasp from my neck, the female was laying face up. Ofc. M. Hansell had control of her right arm and I was trying to gain control of her left arm. At this time, the female tried to kick Ofc. M. Hansell multiple times. Ofc. M. Hansell was able to create distance to avoid being struck. I had to use my body weight to pin the female's legs down by sitting on her upper thigh/hip area to prevent her from striking us. During this time, the female continued to scream "get out of here" and "are you fucking kidding me".

The female then asked, "why are you sitting on me, are you going to try and kill me like George Floyd". Ofc. M. Hansell and I tried to get the female to calm down. I removed myself from the female and asked her to flip over her. She stated, "no". The female continued to lay on her right side with her legs bent. I had to grab her ankles and straighten her legs out so we could physically flip her over on to her belly. The female continued to scream and resists the officer's commands. She continued to scream, "why are you dragging me on the floor, what the fuck is wrong with you and why are you doing this to me".

Ofc. M. Hansell and I were able to get her on her belly and place her hands behind her back so we could attempt to handcuff her. Ofc. R. Perez had to assists us in safely placing handcuffs on the female.

Once the female was cuffed, I was able to locate some clothes for her so we could get her covered up. At this time, I was able to place jean shorts on her that had been located on the top of the dresser right inside of the door. I asked Lauren multiple times if I could retrieve a shirt out of her suitcase for her. She stated, "I want a lawyer and I want a lawyer now". Ofc. M. Hansell was able to locate a shirt for her so she could be covered while we transported her to jail. While I was placing the shirt on her, she stated, "pretend I am your mother, and this is protocol because you're being a fucking asshole". I informed the female that my mother would not grab me by the neck. She also stated, "you tried to kill me".

At this time, we sat the female up so she would not have any breathing issues laying face down. While trying to roll her on to her side to lift her, she stated, "I have been violated man, I feel like I have been raped".

Ofc. M. Hansell was able to locate a New Jersey Driver's License for the female. She was identified as Lauren Boyer (9/9/1974).

Sgt. Rodriguez and Sgt. Sims arrived and assessed the suspect for any injuries.

Ofc. Perez and both Sergeants attempted to stand the female up to walk her to a patrol car for transport. The female began to scream. I asked Ofc. Perez if he had a hobble in his vehicle, he was able to locate it and I handed in to Sgt. Rodriguez. Lauren Boyer was hobbled, and officers assisted in walking her to Ofc. R. Perez's patrol vehicle. Ofc. R. Perez transported Lauren to the Monroe County Detention Center.

It should be noted that Craig and Lauren had been romantically involved for three years and were engaged. At this time, I believe there is probable cause that on April 6th, 2021, Lauren M Boyer did knowingly and intentionally push me (Officer Deese) and use her arm to grab me around the back of my neck while tightening her grip, but not affecting my consciousness or breathing after I had announced myself as law enforcement and I was wearing my department issued uniform and badge which made me easily recognizable as law enforcement which violates F.S.S. F.S.S 784.07-2B Battery on Law Enforcement.

At this time, I believe there is probable cause that on April 6th, 2021, Lauren M Boyer did knowingly, intentionally and willfully resisted officers with violence by kicking her feet while officers were trying to get her to comply and physically pushing me and grabbing Ofc. M. Hansell and I while all officers on scene were in their department issued uniforms and easily recognized as Law Enforcement Officers which violated F.S.S 843.01 Resist Officer with Violence.

On 04-06-2021 @ 0204hrs., I K-9 Ofc. Matthew Hansell of the Key West Police Department, responded to Southwinds Motel in reference to a trespass.

Upon arrival, myself Ofc. Deese and Ofc. Perez made contact with Evan, an employee with Southwinds. Evan told us a female staying in room #25 wanted a male subject removed from the property. At the time of the call, we were under the impression the male and female were strangers that had met earlier in the evening.

We made contact with the male, Craig Fluty, who spoke with Ofc. Perez and only wanted to retrieve his belongings from room #25. Fluty did not seem under the influence and was very cooperative with us while Ofc. Perez obtained his demographic information.

While Ofc. Perez spoke with Fluty, I walked over to room #25 with Ofc. Deese and Evan. Evan knocked on the door and asked for the female Lauren Boyer, to open the door so that we could speak with her.

Boyer refused to open the door initially and cursed at us. This back and forth with Boyer went on for several minutes. By this time I told Boyer she had two options. Option one was to open the door so we could get Fluty's belongings or option two, go to jail for theft.

Boyer aggressively opened the door. I could smell a strong odor of alcohol coming from the room. Ofc. Deese went in and attempted to get Fluty's phone charger and belongings, however she was blocked from doing so by Boyer.

Boyer literally launched Fluty's luggage in the direction of Ofc. Deese, who passed Fluty's luggage to the front porch and I took both bags off the porch and handed them off to Evan.

After we had obtained all of Fluty's belongings from the room, I began to walk toward the front of the hotel. I heard Boyer raising her voice yelling at Ofc. Deese. As I turned around I heard Ofc. Deese yell something to the effect, "Don't touch me!" I then saw Ofc. Deese and Boyer become locked in a physical struggle at the door. Ofc. Deese was locked in what can be described as a head locked by Boyer. Ofc. Deese grabbed a hold of Boyer around the shoulders locking her up as well and quickly directed Boyer to the ground.

I ran up and grabbed Boyer by the right hand and eventually used my right leg to pin Boyer to the deck and side wall of the room to keep her from flailing about.

Ofc. Deese helped maintain control and I took Ofc. Perez handcuffs and with the assistance of Ofc. Deese we placed Boyer into handcuffs.

I advised over the radio of what had occurred and requested a supervisor to our location.

Sgt. Sims and Sgt. A. Rodriguez arrived soon after. Sgt. Sims tried to calmly speak with Boyer, who continued to curse and yell now directing her anger at Sgt. Sims. Myself and Sgt. Sims even attempted to stand Boyer up to make her more comfortable, however she refused to stand and flailed on her back making it difficult for us to control her. Boyer was eventually hobbled by officers.

Once Boyer was secure, I walked to the front of the hotel and made contact with Fluty, giving him his watch and cell phone charger. I spoke with Fluty briefly ad he told me Boyer was actually his fiance. Fluty said they went to the Bull and Whistle as well as Irish Kevin's Bar before returning to the hotel. Fluty said it was out of character for Boyer to act the way she was acting and he thought Boyer might be under the influence of a narcotic slipped in her drink.

If Fluty and Boyer would have been honest in their relationship status from the beginning of the call, it would have changed the whole dynamics of how this incident would have played out. Having that information we could have asked for Fluty to find another hotel room in order to avoid a confrontation with Boyer, who might not have had any interaction with the police.

I asked Fluty how much Boyer had to drink and he told me a few drinks. I told Fluty that his fiance would be going to the Monroe County Jail and that she would probably call him in the morning.

I spoke with Sgt. Sims and Sgt. A. Rodriguez and de-brief before heading back to the police station to complete a supplemental report.

My Axon body camera was used for this case.

On 04/06/2021, at 0204 hours, Ofc. M. Hansell, Ofc. Deese and I (Ofc. R. Perez) were dispatched to 1321 Simonton St. in reference to a trespass.

Upon arrival we spoke to the manager on duty a male identified as Evan Nguyen. Nguyen stated he had a couple that was staying together in a room. The room was under the female's name and the female locked the male half of the party out of the room. The female stated she did not want the male to return to the room because she was concerned for her safety. The female also stated she did not want the male to stay at the same property. The male refused to leave the property after being instructed to do so by Nguyen.

Nguyen led me to the male who was later identified by his New York DL as Craig Fluty. Fluty stated he wanted to rent another room at the same establishment. I explained to Fluty that Nguyen was refusing to rent him another room on the property and he wanted him to leave. Fluty asked if it were possible for us to retrieve his phone charger and his backpack. Ofc. Deese and Ofc. M. Hansell went to room 25 to meet with the female in an attempt to retrieve Fluty's belongings.

While I was telling Fluty about other hotels in the area, he could potentially rent a room. I heard screaming coming from the vicinity of room 25. I made my way to room 25 and saw Ofc. Deese and Ofc. M. Hansell on the ground attempting to detain a nude female who was screaming and flailing around. I ran over and assisted in handcuffing the female later identified by her New Jersey DL as Lauren Boyer. Boyer continued to scream and flail around on the ground. Boyer was completely undressed so Ofc. Deese grabbed a pair of shorts and a T-shirt and put them on Boyer while she was detained. We sat Boyer up and she continued to scream at Ofc. Deese.

I was instructed by Sgt. A. Rodriguez to bring a patrol vehicle to Elizabeth St. I retrieved my vehicle and drove it around to room 25. Boyer refused to walk to my patrol vehicle, so she was placed in a hobble and walked to my patrol vehicle. I transported Boyer to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident.
