This email serves to formally inform Key West Bight of our intention to purchase the vessel Afternoon Delight III and, in doing so, reassign the C-Dock lease to our name. As of May 12, 2021, we have entered into a purchase and sale agreement with the vessel's current owner, Allen King. After hopeful approval from the Key West Bight Board, and closing on the purchase, our plan is to relocate the Afternoon Delight III by November of 2021 and replace it with our 53' party fishing/head boat, the Cora Beth. With the Cora Beth, our hope is to run daily public fishing trips for up to 25 passengers. We feel as though the City of Key West has a rich history of and reputation for fishing. With the departure of the Greyhound III from Garrison Bight and the Tortuga from Conch Harbor, there appears to be a void in the current opportunities available to tourists and locals alike to participate in head boat fishing trips.

Cory has previously operated similar boats out of marinas owned by the City of Key West, including Key West Bight, between 2005-2013. Most recently, he was a captain of the Gulfstream III and the Yankee Freedom II and III. Due to his experience, he has a solid understanding of the waters, fishing grounds, and local/tourist desire for this type of fishing.
