A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO THE CONCH REPUBLIC SEAFOOD COMPANY FOR A STATIC BOAT & CAR DISPLAY ON NOVEMBER 11, 2021 FROM 11:00 A.M. TO 10:00 P.M; A FLORIDA POWER BOAT FASHION SHOW ON NOVEMBER 12, 2021 FROM 7:00 P.M. TO 11:00 P.M. AND AWARDS CEREMONY DURING THE FLORIDA POWER BOAT EVENT AT THE CONCH REPUBLIC SEAFOOD COMPANY 631 GREENE STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 P.M. TO 11:00 P.M. ON NOVEMBER 10-13, 2021; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Conch Republic Seafood Company has applied to the City for a Special Event Permit for an event to take place from November 10-13, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this event shall take place at 631 Greene Street at the Conch Republic Seafood Company.

WHEREAS, amplified music will be played during the event;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City

SECTION 3. That the Conch Republic Seafood Company is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the place and time as herein described.

SECTION 4. That the Conch Republic Seafood Company will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by the Commission or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the community.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage an
