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On 05/23/2021, at 1916 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was dispatched to 733 United St. in reference to a criminal mischief.

Upon arrival I met with a female identified by her Florida DL as Cheryl Allen. Allen stated she was inside her house when she heard her dogs barking at something outside of the house. She heard a loud noise and walked outside to see what it was. She looked and noticed her Yamaha Zuma scooter was laying on its side. She noticed a white male, wearing a blue "puffy" vest, board shorts, with long brown hair, and a beard walking away. She asked the male what he did, and he stated, "I just saved your life." The male then walked south bound on Elizabeth St. and turned west bound on South St. Allen called the KWPD nonemergency number to report what had occurred. Allen stated one of the scooter's side mirrors was in her porch. Upon inspection of the area I noticed a hole in the screen that surrounds the porch, big enough to fit a scooter's side mirror through. The sound heard was most likely the side mirror that was thrown through the screen smacking against the wall of Allen's house. I asked Allen if she wanted to press charges and she stated that she did.

Allen called the KWPD nonemergency number at 1916 hours and I arrived shortly after. Due to the position of the sun and the lighting in that area it was hard to tell whether somebody was in Allen's porch or not.

Sgt. A. Rodriguez, Ofc. Hudson, Ofc. Ane and I were driving around the downtown area looking for the suspect. Sgt. A. Rodriguez advised he was with a male fitting the description given by Allen on Whitehead and Virginia St. I drove to Sgt. A. Rodriguez's location.

Upon arrival I saw a white male later identified by his Florida DL as Joshua Morgan. Morgan was wearing a puffy blue jacket, board shorts, he had long brown hair and a beard. I got out of my patrol vehicle and introduced myself to Morgan. I told Morgan I needed to speak with him. Morgan sounded agitated and told me we needed to maintain social distance. Morgan began to walk backwards I told Morgan to stop because he was well past the 6-foot mark and he began to walk away. I approached Morgan he walked away from me and I grabbed his arms and attempted to place him in handcuffs. Morgan pulled away and began to run east bound on Virginia St. Sgt. A. Rodriguez and I ran after Morgan in an attempt to detain Morgan. Sgt. A. Rodriguez used his TASER to try to incapacitate Morgan. Morgan's jacket was too thick, and the probes were unable to make contact with his body (See Sgt. A. Rodriguez's supplemental report.) Morgan ran behind a car into the street colliding with me. I grabbed Morgan's upper torso and guided him toward the ground in a controlled manner. While on the ground we gave Morgan several loud verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. Morgan refused to comply and was drive stunned by Sgt. A. Rodriguez. Morgan then placed his hands behind his back, and we were able to place him in handcuffs.

Morgan was placed in the back seat of my marked patrol vehicle. I read Morgan his Miranda rights and asked him if he would like to speak with me. Morgan stated he did not understand his rights. I read it again and he interrupted me midway through. I read it a third time and Morgan refused to speak with me.

Morgan was taken to Lower Keys Medical Center to be medically evaluated and cleared to be taken to the Monroe County Detention Center. We arrived at Lower Keys Medical Center and Morgan was cleared by the doctor to go to jail.

While in route to MCDC Morgan stated "Perez huh you're a spic, aren't you? Where are you from Mexico? I'm going to get an axe and cut your head off you nigger"

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause, that on 05/23/2021, Joshua Morgan did

knowingly and intentionally push over Cheryl Allen`s scooter damaging her side mirrors. Morgan also threw a side mirror at Allen`s porch damaging Allen`s screen violating F.S.S. 806.13(1)(b)(1) criminal mischief under \$200.00.

Morgan wantonly and maliciously threw the side mirror into an occupied building in a manner that could`ve caused property damage, great bodily harm or death had he struck somebody on the porch. Due to the time of day and the lack of lighting in the area it was hard to determine whether there was a person on the other side of the screen. Morgan throwing the side mirror without regard for human life or safety violates F.S.S. 790.19 shooting missile into dwelling.

While attempting to detain Morgan he pulled away and then ran away not allowing me (a law enforcement officer) to lawfully execute my legal duty violating F.S.S. 843.02 resisting officer without violence.

Finally, Morgan threatened to cut my head off with an axe, while I was wearing a KWPD class b uniform and knowing I am a police officer/public servant, violating F.S.S. 838.021(3)(b) Corruption by threat against public servant.

My AXON BWC was not activated until after Morgan was detained due to him attempting to flee before I could activate my camera. My AXON in car camera was activated during transport. I took nine pictures of the damaged side mirrors, damaged screen and the tipped over scooter.

On Sunday, May 23, 2021 at approximately 1954 hours, I (Sgt. A. Rodriguez) was on routine patrol in the area of Amelia and Whitehead Streets when I saw a male fitting the description of Ofc. R. Perez's suspect in a criminal mischief case.

I stopped on the corner of Virginia and Whitehead Street and called to the male to stop. Ofc. R. Perez arrived on scene and also began to speak with the male. The male, later identified as Joshua Morgan, refused to stay still despite being told by Ofc. R. Perez and I to stop. Morgan then began walking away at which point Ofc. R. Perez gained control of him and used a nearby wall to keep him from moving again. I retrieved my TASER and turned it on and pointed it at Morgan in an attempt to gain compliance. Morgan continued to attempt to pull away and tense. I gained control of Morgan's right arm via his jacket while Ofc. R. Perez attempted to retrieve his handcuffs.

Morgan then broke free from Ofc. R. Perez's grip and began to flee eastbound on Virginia Street. I gave Morgan loud verbal commands to stop and deployed my TASER in dart firing mode. Both of the probes struck Morgan's left arm and achieved sporadic neuromuscular incapacitation (NMI), but not enough to halt Morgan's actions. Morgan continued running and I turned off my TASER, dropped the expelled cartridge, and continued to give chase on foot.

Morgan stopped abruptly and attempted to run around a street sign and behind a vehicle. I still had my TASER in my right hand and gained control of Morgan's left arm. I pulled the trigger on my TASER to deliver a five-second cycle of a drive stun to Morgan's lower back area.

Ofc. R. Perez arrived and gained control of Morgan and took him down to the ground in a controlled manner via a modified arm bar takedown. Ofc. R. Perez and I were able to gain control of Morgan's arms and place him into handcuffs. Ofc. R. Perez and I subsequently placed Morgan into the rear of Ofc. R. Perez's patrol vehicle.

During the time we had contact with Morgan, he appeared to be in an altered mental status, speaking unintelligibly and asking for "Barack" to save him.

I gathered the expelled cartridge, anti-felon identification confetti (AFIDs), and blast doors and later submitted them into KWPD Property as evidence.

My AXON BWC was activated for this incident. I did not have an in-car video of this incident.

I had no further involvement in this case.
