## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), APPROVING STAFF RANKING OF RESPONSES TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) NO. 005-21 FOR PRIVATE SERVICES SECURITY (KEY WEST BIGHT); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS, UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; AUTHORIZING BUDGET TRANSFERS AND ADJUSTMENTS, NECESSARY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City issued a request for Proposals for Private Security Services for Port and Marinas - including the Key West Bight, as set forth in RFP No. 005-21; and

WHEREAS, on May 26, 2021, the City Clerk opened five responsive proposals, and a committee comprised of City staff reviewed and ranked the responses to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2021, the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended award of the RFP to Ralons Security, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission sitting as the CRA approves the staff ranking of responses to RFP No. 005-21 for Private Security Services as follows:

- (1) Ralons Security, LLC
- (2) <u>American Guard Services</u>, Inc.
- (3) St. Moritz Security Services
- (4) Kemp Group Int. Corp.
- (5) Blue Shield Security and Protection

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract with Ralons Security, LLC, in substantial conformance with documents in the RFP response, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That funds for private security are budgeted in Key West Bight accounts: #405-7503-575-3400, 405-7504-575-3400, 405-7505-575-3400 and 405-7506-575-3400, and any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.
