In reference to your request for video(s) involving Mrs. Susan Wildrick's complaint, a link has been sent to the Citizen's Review Board Email (CRB@Cityofkeywest-fl.gov).

Based on my research into this incident, I do not believe there to be any violation of KWPD policy or Florida state statute by Sergeant Pablo Rodriguez, Officer Scott Standerwick and Officer Alioht Valdes-Marrero. I also do not find any deficient service provided by the officers involved for the following reasons:

- Based on Mrs. Wildrick's original complaint to the Citizen's Review Board, regarding rudeness, officers on scene did not use any foul/vulgar language before, during or after the encounter with Mrs. Wildrick. Even after Mrs. Wildrick used several obscenities directed to the officers.
- Mrs. Wildrick's alleged that Sgt, Rodriguez would not provide his information, however in Ofc. Standerwick's BWC video at approximately 31:50 and in Sgt. Rodriguez's BWC video at approximately 01:52, it shows Sgt. Rodriguez writing his information and providing it to Wildrick's huband, who arrives on scene.
- Sgt. Rodriguez grabbing of Wildrick's right wrist was within the department's, "Response to Resistance Policy" (General Order 02.08).
- Sgt. Rodriguez used the discretion of which, he felt an arrest would be more effective based on the responses provided to him by Mrs. Wildrick. Sgt. Rodriguez exercised his options which conforms with the department's, "Use of Discretion and Alternatives to Arrest Policy" (General Order 01.05).
- Mrs. Wildrick's allegation of being untruthful, is it a general complaint of the entire incident or a particular instance? After reviewing Reports/Videos/CAD Notes and the complaint, the arrest is documented based on Ofc. Valdes-Marrero reviewing BWC Video of Sgt. Rodriguez.
