- The homeownership rate is 36% in Tract 9724, compared to 41% in Key West.
- Median household income is \$50,566 (approximately 70% of AMI) in Tract
 9724, compared to \$69,630 (approximately 90% of AMI) in Key West.
- <u>Renters in Tract 9724 have particularly low incomes</u>, and the disparity between renters and homeowners is wider in the neighborhood than in the city. In Tract 9724, median renter income is \$32,213, (less than 30% of AMI) compared to \$115,855 for owners; in the city, median renter income is \$55,955 (approximately 80% of AMI) and median owner income is \$97,171.

- 27% of the Tract 9724 population is non-White, compared to 20% of the city population.

In sum, there is a significant discrepancy between the city median renter income (\$55,955 - 80% of AMI) and the Bahama Village median renter income (\$32,213 - less than 30% of AMI).
