ACTION STATEMENT

Resolution approving award for Invitation to Bid (ITB) #21-018 E-Dock 3-Phase Pedestal Upgrade – Key West Historic Seaport to Nearshore Electric, Inc, authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract in the amount of \$96,483 and approving necessary budget transfer.

BACKGROUND

The Key West Bight Marina facilitates various size transient vessels. When the Seaport was developed in the mid-1990's single-phase power was run to all the piers as was standard at the time. Providing the upgraded pedestal will eliminate the use of pigtail plugs and converters/inverters for the newer and larger transient vessels fitted with 3-phase power.

The Key West Bight Management District Board approved this item at their October 13, 2021 meeting.

PURPOSE & JUSTIFICATION

ITB #21-018 E-Dock 3-Phase Pedestal Upgrade – Key West Historic Seaport was advertised in early September 2021 seeking bids from qualified individuals or firms in marine electrical work. Two (2) responses were received on September 29, 2021. Bids were reviewed by Seaport Staff and Nearshore Electric, Inc was determined to be the lowest of both responsive bidders.

RECOMMENDATION

Key West Bight Management District Board recommends approving award for ITB #21-018 E-Dock 3-Phase Pedestal Upgrade – Key West Historic Seaport to Nearshore Electric, Inc, authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract in the amount of \$96,483 and approving the necessary budget transfer.
