On August 6, 2021, at approximately 1910 hours, Detective M. del Valle, United States Deputy Marshal Eric Hannah, and I (Detective Malsheimer) were on the 300 block of Duval Street. We were attempting to find a subject, Jeremy Allen Hewitt (DOB 08/06/1999), that had an active arrest warrant out of Virginia for sexual battery on a victim that is mentally incapacitated/helpless.

We made contact with Hewitt in front of 301 Duval Street. I addressed Hewitt by his name, I identified myself as "Key West Police", and I informed him to place his hands behind his back because he had a warrant. My KWPD bage and my firearm were exposed during the encounter. I grabbed Hewitt by his right wrist and Detective M. del Valle grabbed him by his left wrist and we began to simultaneously move his hands behind his back. Hewitt immediately tensed his arms and attempted to move his arms back in front of his body. Deputy Marshal Hannah was positioned directly in front of Hewitt. We were able to use joint manipulation to control Hewitt as he resisted our efforts to handcuff him. I was ultimately able to place Hewitt into handcuffs.

We escorted Hewitt to the 500 block of Caroline Street, just east of the intersection of Duval Street and away from the crowded area of Duval Street. I informed KWPD Dispatch of the arrest and requested a Patrol unit to respond for transportation.

Detective M. del Valle and Deputy Marshal Hannah searched Hewitt as we waited for Patrol. As Deputy Marshal Hannah was standing directly next to Hewitt he was holding his arms. Without provocation, Hewitt leaned his body forward in a sprinting position, broke free from Deputy Marshal Hannah's grasp and began running east on Caroline Street. Within a short distance, I grabbed Hewitt by the chain of the handcuffs he was wearing and began to pull back in the opposite direction he was running. Hewitt continued his evasive movements in an obvious effort to escape custody. As Hewitt was running and in close proximity to me, I used both of my legs to wrap around his legs causing him to lose balance. At the same time, Deputy Marshal Hannah tackled Hewitt from behind. Hewitt went to the ground. Detective M. del Valle came to us and we again gained control of Hewitt.

Sergeant A. Rodriguez, Officer Litton, Officer Howell and Officer Ham arrived on scene. Sergeant A. Rodriguez asked Hewitt what he was thinking and Hewitt said he had a warrant for something he didn't do. We never told Hewitt what the warrant was for prior to this statement. I asked Officers on scene to hobble Hewitt to further prevent escape or resistance. Hewitt was escorted into Officer Litton's patrol vehicle. Officer Litton transported Hewitt to the Monroe County Detention Center without further incident. Officer Litton completed the paperwork for Hewitt's warrant arrest (KWPD Case # 21-4227).

The incident was recorded on both mine and Detective M. del Valle's body-worn cameras.

This case is cleared by arrest.
