On Saturday August 7, 2021, at about 309 am, Ofc. A. Litton and I, Ofc. (L. Hernandez), were dispatched to 218 Duval Street (Teaser's), in reference to a domestic battery incident.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Litton and I met with Quinton Ali Anderson (DOB 05/11/1987) (Arrestee) and Isiah Nathaniel Skinner (09/08/1998) (Arrestee). Ofc. Litton went inside to try to get the surveillance footage showing the domestic battery incident while I stayed with Skinner and Anderson. I later found out that Skinner had nothing to do with the incident Anderson was involved in, but he insisted on staying and I found this out I asked him multiple times to leave the area. Skinner and Anderson were both under the influence of alcoholic intoxicants as per their slurred speech, glassy eyes, strong odor of alcoholic beverages emanating from their body and breath and inability to stand without losing their balance. I detained Skinner and Anderson and I had them both sit on a bench for their safety.

While I was running their identifications on Key West Com. 2, they both tried getting up from the bench and I had to ordered them back down several times. Anderson complied but Skinner grabbed my left wrist and tried to twist it pulled me towards him and shoved me back. Skinner's active resistance, which he clearly tried several times by trying to defeat my lawful orders lead me to bring the situation under control by redirecting his attacks by freeing myself from his grab and I grabbed him by his left arm, bringing him down to the ground in a controlled manner.

Once on the ground Ofc. Litton and I put handcuffs on Skinner. I brought him down to my patrol vehicle and conducted a search incident to arrest of his person. As Ofc. Litton and I were trying to place Skinner in my patrol vehicle he started to resist by tensing up and throwing his body around as dead weight obviously to make it difficult for us. We asked Skinner multiple times to stop resisting in get inside the patrol vehicle and he would not comply. I warned Skinner we were going to have to use our tasers on him if he would not comply. Ofc. Litton used his taser on Skinner twice in drive stun mode on his right ribcage. Skinner would comply and was pushing his weight towards the outside of the patrol vehicle. I had to use my taser in drive stun mode four times on Skinner to gain compliance. I drove stunned Skinner once on his right abdomen, twice on his upper left and right legs and once on his left foot. Each time Skinner was drive stunned I would allow a few seconds and ask him to comply, but he would not until the last drive stun on his foot. We had to push him into the patrol vehicle, and he would try to bring his legs out of to prevent us from closing the door.

During transport Skinner was screaming from the top of his lungs and would tell me "fuck you, let me go" and made incoherent statements. I transported Skinner to the Monroe County Detention Center where he had to be placed in a re strain chair due to his aggressive behavior. Skinner kept using profanity towards myself and the deputies as we were securing him to the chair. Skinner was turned over to the Detention Deputies without further incidents.

Based in all facts and evidence, I believe Skinner on August 7th, 2021 committed the felony criminal offense of battery on law enforcement officer as described in F.S. 784.07-2B. Skinner grabbed me and tried to pull me towards him and shoved me to the side to try to defeat lawful orders. During my encounter with Skinner, I was wearing my Key West Police issued Class B uniform that clearly identifies me as a law enforcement officer.

Based in facts and evidence, I believe Skinner on August 7th, 2021 committed the misdemeanor criminal offense resisting an officer without violence to his / her person as described in F.S. 843.02. Skinner made multiple attempts to prevent us from placing him into my patrol vehicle and intentionally resisted by tensing up and throwing his weight around to make it difficult for us to make a lawful arrest.

My BWC and Axon Fleet (3452) were both activated during this incident. Nothing further at this time.

On 08/07/2021 at approximately 0330 hours, Officer L. Hernandez and I (Ofc. A. Litton) were dispatched to 218 Duval Street, Teasers, to investigate a domestic battery.

While I was inside Teasers conducting my investigation, Officer L. Hernandez stood outside with two male subjects believed to be involved with the initial incident, Isaiah Skinner and Quinton Anderson. Anderson was the suspect of the domestic battery and was subsequently arrested. Skinner was a bystander who repeatedly interfered with the investigation and refused to leave the area after multiple requests made by Officer L. Hernandez.

While inside speaking with the reporting party and victim, Officer L. Hernandez came into Teasers and requested my assistance. Officer L. Hernandez then informed me Skinner was to be arrested for battery on a law enforcement. Officer L. Hernandez took Skinner to the ground and placed him in handcuffs. Skinner repeatedly resisted almost every command given to him while taking him into custody. We escorted Skinner down the stairs to where he continued to resist by refusing to enter Officer L. Hernandez's patrol vehicle. After ample warnings of being drive-stunned and time given to comply by entering the vehicle, I delivered two drive stuns to Skinner's thigh with my department issued Taser. As we supported the weight of Skinner and numerous more attempts to place him in the vehicle, Officer L. Hernandez also deployed drive-stuns with his department issued Taser until Skinner was placed in the vehicle.

Officer L. Hernandez transported Skinner to MCDC while I finished my investigation and arrest for domestic battery. Axon BWC was activated during this incident and later uploaded to Evidence.com.
