On August 29, 2021 at approximately 2241 hours, Ofc. Agleev responded to a traffic crash near to 200 block of Duval Street. Ofc. Agleev requested another unit to assist him, and I, Ofc. Lopez started making my way to the crash scene.

Upon arrival, I talked to Ofc. Agleev and he informed that a witness saw the driver of the golf cart backing up the golf cart and then struck a scooter that was parked behind the golf cart. Ofc. Agleev told me he smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the driver's breath. I told Ofc. Agleev to get the witness for me and the witness shortly after walked up to me. The witness was later identified with his Florida driver's license as Orel Lopez Chirino, (dob:08/14/1972). Orel spoke to me in Spanish, and I am fluent in Spanish which I understood everything Orel said to me. Orel said he was seated on the bar stool located at the main entrance of "Teasers" located at 218 Duval Street. Orel said he saw the golf cart that was parked in the cab stand striking the moped that was parked behind the golf cart. Orel told me he saw the scooter underneath the golf cart at some point and the driver continue pressing the gas pedal with her leg. Orel said he believed the driver was drunk because the driver appeared as if she was not aware that she just struck the scooter. Orel said he walked up to the driver side and he moved the driver's leg from the gas pedal. Orel told me he removed the key from the ignition. Orel said he walked up to the golf cart in an attempt to avoid a crash from happening with the lane of traffic traveling north on the 200 block of Duval Street. Orel told me he waited for Key West Police Officers responding to the scene to return the golf cart's key. Orel had eyes on the driver and then Ofc. Agleev arrived shortly after. Orel told me he recorded with his cellphone while the driver was seated on the driver side, behind the wheel of the golf cart. I reviewed the video, and I confirmed the driver was seated on the driver side, behind the wheel of the golf cart. (It should be noted that the rear passenger side of the golf cart was on top of the curb while the driver was seated in the driver seat of the golf cart). I saw the scooter laying down on the curb and partially encroaching on the road behind the golf cart. I gathered personal information from Orel and then Orel went back to his job. Orel is currently employed by Teaser as a barker, and Orel spends most of his shift on front/main entrance of the establishment. Orel was located approximately 8-12 feet from the traffic crash.

The golf cart involved in this traffic crash was bearing a Florida registration LHAF10. The scooter that was struck by the golf cart was bearing Florida registration 3527NP.

When I first arrived on scene, I noticed the female driver from Orel's recording was seated on passenger side of the golf cart. I walked up to the female driver and she was standing behind the golf cart at this point. The driver was later identified with her New York driver's license as Deborah Gadonniex, (dob:04/02/1971). Ofc. Agleev completed his traffic crash investigation, and I began my DUI investigation.

I noticed Deborah was swaying and placed her hands on the metal edge of the golf cart to help herself maintaining her balance. I asked Deborah how she was doing and she said, "Good, thank you" and then Deborah said, "I don't have anything". Deborah said she was going to call the company of the golf cart and have them pick up the golf cart. Deborah said, "I'm insured and everything". I reminded Deborah why we were there and then I had to lean forward to be able to listen to Deborah. When I leaned forward to Deborah, I smelled a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage. I noticed Deborah had glassy eyes and droopy eyelids. A lot people/pedestrians were walking by and several vehicles driving on the 200 block of Duval Street. I asked Deborah where she was driving from and Deborah said she was hanging out with her friends. Deborah said, "The gas pedal" and then Deborah said, "My friend was driving". Deborah said, "I got in and tried to reverse" and then Deborah said, "Whatever happened". Deborah told me, "I don't even know". Deborah told me she could not talk about this until she seats down because it was getting

hot for her. I told Deborah I want to be able to have a conversation with her and I asked her to please walk with me to better location. The location we went to was the 400 block of Caroline Street, which is close to the intersection of Duval Street and Caroline Street.

Ofc. Agleev and I walked with Deborah and I told Deborah the situation. I told Deborah Ofc. Agleev and I both agree that she is under the influence of an alcohol beverage. Deborah interrupted me and Deborah said, "But I was not driving". I told Deborah to please listen to me and Deborah said, "Yeah I was drinking" and then Deborah said, "Yes, I am not going to lie to you". I told Deborah I can smell the alcoholic beverage on her breath and Deborah said, "I can smell it on my own breath". I told Deborah you have a little bit of slurred speech and Deborah said, "Yes, always". I told Deborah that I believe she was operating the vehicle under the influence of an alcoholic beverage and Deborah continued interrupting me several times when I was explaining her the situation. Deborah proceeded to lean/sit on a small concrete fence while I talked to her. I asked Deborah if she is willing to participate in Field Sobriety Exercises to dispel my suspicion that she was operating a motor vehicle to the point her normal faculties as a person were impaired at the time. Deborah replied, "Absolutely not". Deborah continued interrupting me again. At this moment Deborah was standing on the sidewalk. Deborah said repeatedly that she was not driving. Deborah demanded to see footage and made it clear that she was not going to participate on Field Sobriety Exercises.

It was very obvious Deborah did not want to cooperate with me and Ofc. Agleev. I made the arrest decision based on what I have seen of her so far.

Based on my training and experience and the totality of circumstances, her physical appearance and odor of an alcoholic beverage. I believe Deborah was impaired by either an alcoholic beverage and/or chemical substance which impaired her normal faculties to safely operate a motor vehicle.

I told Deborah to turn around and place her hands behind her back. I grabbed Deborah's left wrist and Deborah began pulling away her wrists away from us. When I was trying to place handcuffs on Deborah, I redirected Deborah's body against a fence to be able to gain control of her hands. Once Deborah's body was up against the fence Deborah continued pulling away her arms away from us. I told Deborah to stop resisting several times and Deborah did not comply. Deborah was leaning back while Ofc. Agleev and I were placing handcuffs on her. Deborah asked me multiple times why did I push her against the fence. I told Deborah that she did not follow my verbal commands and was resisting arrest. I requested a supervisor to the scene. Ofc. Agleev opened the rear passenger side of my vehicle and I instructed Deborah to get inside of my vehicle. I had to instruct Deborah to place her feet inside my vehicle several times. Deborah refused to put her feet inside my vehicle. I grabbed Deborah's legs and I put them inside the vehicle to be able to close the door.

Sgt. A. Rodriguez responded to the scene and I explained to Sgt. A. Rodriguez what took place. Sgt. A. Rodriguez spoke with Deborah and he used his Axon capture app to photograph Deborah's face. Deborah mentioned she was going to have bruises the following day. It should be noted that Deborah had an antagonistic demeanor while speaking to Sgt. A. Rodriguez. Sgt. A. Rodriguez gave Deborah very simple instructions and Deborah did not follow Sgt. A. Rodriguez's instructions. Deborah refused to get back inside my vehicle after her face was photographed.

I transported Deborah to the Monroe County Detention Center. My in-car Axon camera was activated during the

transportation, 3722.

This incident was recorded with my body worn camera, 3722.

I arrived at the Sally port, (MCDC) at approximately 0012 hours.

I then began the twenty (20) minute observation period at 0021 hours. During the required 20-minute observation, Deborah did not take anything orally, did not regurgitate or touch her mouth.

After the 20-minute observation, I requested Deborah consent to a lawful test of her breath. She did not consent. I read Deborah her implied consent and she still refused to provide the breath sample. It should be noted, I am a certified breath test operator in the State of Florida and do possess a valid, in date, permit to administer such test. The instrument used is the Intoxilyzer 8000 S/N 80-006693.

Deborah was issued the following UNIFORM DUI CITATION: AEU4ZDE.

Deborah was assigned a Court date on September 08, 2021 with Judge Wilson, 9:00 am, at the Key West Courthouse. Deborah refused to sign her citation. I made several attempts to get a signature from Deborah and she continued with her antagonistic demeanor towards me. It should be noted that Deborah mentioned her 16-year-old son was inside a hotel room by himself while I was in the DUI room. I requested an Officer to perform a welfare check on the juvenile. Ofc. Hudson later was able to make contact with an adult who is Deborah's friend. Deborah's friend was going to be able to look after the juvenile. While I was communicating with Ofc. Hudson over Channel five providing the address/name of the juvenile, Deborah was being difficult, and she began asking several questions. Deborah's questions were answered by me several times while we were in the DUI room. I told Deborah she was repeating herself several times. I told Deborah I was trying my best to get the information out and have an Officer check on her son and Deborah showed no regards for the safety of her 16-year-old son. Deborah refused to sign the citation. This was captured with my body worn camera, 3722.

Deborah was issued the following UNIFORM DUI CITATION: AEU4ZFE. Refusal to accept and sign citation.

Based on the facts and evidence, Deborah Gadonniex, did knowingly and willfully oppose to follow my verbal commands. I told Deborah to turn around and place her hands behind her back. I grabbed Deborah's left wrist and Deborah began pulling away her wrists away from us. When I was trying to place handcuffs on Deborah, I redirected Deborah's body against a fence to be able to gain control of her hands. Once Deborah's body was up against the fence Deborah continued pulling away her arms away from us. I told Deborah to stop resisting several times and Deborah did not comply. Deborah was leaning back while Ofc. Agleev and I were placing handcuffs on her. Ofc. Agleev and I were wearing our class B uniform with the Key West Police insignia on our sleeves. Ofc. Agleev and I were recognizable as Police Officers and Deborah opposed to follow our verbal commands. Contrary to F.S.S. 843.02.

Ofc. Agleev had the scooter towed and he informed me the scooter was not operable anymore. Ofc. Agleev had the golf cart towed as well.
