Commissioner Hoover would like to amend the motion to add \$4.00 per hour for all parking in the City of Key West utilizing the funds to meet Rollback and utilizing funds of \$214,00.00 for salary to bring every person making under \$15.00 per hour up to \$15.00 per hour.
