-- Christopher Michael Pipes Arrest Narrative:

On Sunday, February 16, 2025, around 1:45 PM, Officer Standerwick and I were dispatched to Simonton Beach at 0 Simonton Street for a disorderly subject.

The reporting party, a Hyatt jetski employee, told the KWPD dispatchers that a white male in his 40s with dark shorts and no shirt was acting belligerent, causing a scene and exposed himself.

Officer Standerwick was first on scene. Officer Standerwick later told me that the subject disobeyed his verbal commands and was belligerent. Officer Standerwick told me that he waited for my arrival to escalate his response beyond verbal commands.

On scene, I observed the subject swinging his arms back and forth while yelling at Officer Standerwick. I told the subject he needed to identify himself and we were there to investigate his disorderly conduct. The subject refused to identify himself and responded by jumping up onto a concrete barrier which was next to us. At that point I pulled my OC Spray from my belt and prepared to make use of it. The subject jumped from the barrier onto the beach and began walking away from us while continuing to ignore our verbal commands. The subject passively and actively resisted by disobeying our verbal commands and walking away from us. I made use of the OC Spray and sprayed it toward the subject's face. The wind caught the OC Spray and I was also exposed to the Spray in my face temporarily blinding me in my left eye. The subject was also exposed and began to fall to the ground. Officer Standerwick assisted him all the way to the ground in a controlled manner. I assisted Officer Standerwick with handcuffing the subject. I assisted Officer Standerwick with placing the subject in the back of my patrol vehicle. I then sat in the front seat of my patrol vehicle and exposed my eye to the air conditioning which was on full blast. I gained usefulness of my eye after several minutes.

I summoned Key West Rescue to the scene with reference to the OC Spray. Key West Rescue responded to the scene and treated the subject who identified himself by his name and date of birth as Chrisopher Pipes. Key West Rescue cleared Christopher. I transported Christopher to the Monroe County Detention Center. Christopher was apologetic in the back of my patrol car. I inquired if he was having a metal health issue or was intoxicated. He told me he was drunk. I turned Christopher over to the detention deputies without incident.

Officer Standerwick interviewed three witnesses that observed Christopher's disorderly conduct and our response: Calvin Burleson, Melissa Dyrland, and Christopher Ryan.

Sergeant Malsheimer responded to the scene in reference to the Response to Resistance and my exposure.

Christopher violated Florida State Statute 877.03, DISORDERLY CONDUCT. His actions corrupted the public morals, outraged the sense of public decency, and affected the peace and quiet of the many subjects who were at the beach.

Christopher also violated Florida State Statute 843.03 RESIST/OBSTRUCT OFFICER W/O VIOLENCE by passively and actively resisting mine and Officer Standerwick's lawful commands. At the time Officer Standerwick and I were Key West Police Officers engaged in the legal execution of our duties. Christopher should have known we were police officers as we identified ourselves as such and were dressed in our Class B uniforms (Badges, KWPD Patches).

I activated my bodycam and in-car camera during this call.

On 2/16/2025 at 1345 hours I, Ofc Standerwick, responded to Simonton beach in reference to a white male acting erratically at the beach. Dispatch advised that a white male, later identified as Christopher Pipes (Defendant), wearing blue or black shorts is yelling at beachgoers and exposing himself.

As I approached the beach, I could clearly see the Defendant by the boat ramp. The Defendant was yelling and dancing by the boat ramp and beachgoers were clearly off put by his antics. Beachgoers were actively pointing to the Defendant as I arrived to identify him as the problem. The Defendant appeared to me, through my training and experience, to be under the influence of a narcotic or alcohol. This presented itself with his loud outbursts at me when I asked him for identification, and his inability to control his body by his constant movement. After repeated attempts to speak with the Defendant about his behavior, and his lack of response to me, I waited for Ofc Haynie to assist in the situation. Ofc Haynie arrived on scene, and he also asked for the Defendant's identification. The Defendant refused to provide Ofc Haynie his identification and he proceeded to jump on the coffin blocks that block the boat ramp. I circled the coffin block to intercept the Defendant and Ofc Haynie came around with his OC spray at the ready. When we closed the distance Ofc Haynie deployed the OC spray. The Defendant immediately reacted to the OC spray, and he immediately bent over at the waist from the OC effects. At this point I guided the Defendant to the sand and pulled his arms behind his back. Ofc Haynie handcuffed the Defendant, and he was placed in the rear of his KYPD patrol car. I spoke to Witnesses Calvin Burleson, Melissa Dyrland and Christopher Ryan. All stated the Defendant was acting very erratically and was running down the pier making many beachgoers uncomfortable with his antics. Witness Burleson informed me the Defendant at one point was actively making a young girl uncomfortable by making romantic advances to her. All witnesses agreed that the Defendant's conduct outraged the sense of public decency at the beach where they were just trying to enjoy the beach. This incident as well as the interviews with the witnesses are on my BWC and are in property under this case number.
