A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING FORT ZACHARY TAYLOR HISTORIC STATE PARK TO HOLD THE CIVIL WAR HERITAGE DAYS PARADE ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 6, 2026, FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 4:45 P.M. ON DUVAL STREET; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID PARADE FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 4:45 P.M.; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Fort Zachary Taylor Historic State Park wishes to conduct the "Civil War Heritage Days Parade" on Duval Street from the Clinton Place on Front Street to Ft. Zachary Taylor Historic State Park during the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. on Friday, February 6, 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor

therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That Fort Zachary Taylor Historic State Park is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That Fort Zachary Taylor Historic State Park will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That Fort Zachary Taylor Historic State Park acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
