Good Morning Madam Mayor and Commissioners,

There is significant public concern regarding Agenda Item 13, the proposed amendment to the City Manager's contract. While the terms of the amendment are concerning, I am most troubled by its placement on the consent agenda for Wednesday's meeting. An item of this magnitude should not be placed on consent to avoid public notice or discussion.

I respectfully request that you remove Item 13 from the consent agenda and place it on the regular agenda for full public deliberation. The proposed salary increase significantly exceeds the 2026 budget adopted in September, and I would like clarification on the source of these additional funds.

Regarding Item 28, I do not support limiting discussion time for City Commissioners. These meetings are the appropriate forum for discussing city business, and complex issues often warrant extended dialogue. Furthermore, the established meeting schedule is being changed without clear justification. I do not see the necessity for the provisions outlined in Item 28 and request that it be removed from the agenda.
