A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A MOBILE PORT SECURITY GUARD HOUSE FOR OUTER MOLE CRUISE SHIP OPERATIONS FROM UH STRUCTURES - D/B/A EBTECH INDUSTRIAL BUILDING SOLUTIONS PURSUANT TO GSA CONTRACT # GS-07F-0647W MOD PO025, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$66,475.00, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission accepted grant funding for the purchase of a Mobile Port Security Guard House in Resolution No. 13-319; and

WHEREAS, City staff has solicited quotes and recommends the purchase of a Mobile Port Security Guard House for Outer Mole Cruise Ship Operation from UH Structures d/b/a Ebtech Industrial Building Solutions, pursuant to GSA Contract # GS-07F-0647W MOD PO025, pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase is hereby approved of a Mobile Port Security Guard House for Outer Mole Cruise Ship

Operation from UH Structures d/b/a Ebtech Industrial Building Solutions, pursuant to GSA Contract # GS-07F-0647W MOD P0025, pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 2: That 75% of the funding for this purchase is provided through the Department of Homeland Security FY 2013 Port Security Grant #EMW-2013-PU-00094, accepted in Resolution No. 13-319, and 25% is provided by the City.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
