RE: Approval of a 2-Year Extension to the Key West Bight and City

Marina's contract with Clean Harbor Environmental Services.

#### **ACTION STATEMENT:**

This resolution will approve a 2-Year Extension as stipulated within the City's contract with Clean Harbor Environmental Services, which will expire in March 2011, to provide emergency oil spill cleanup services at Key West Bight and the City Marina @ Garrison Bight on an as needed basis at no increase in rates.

### **BACKGROUND:**

In 2008 emergency oil spill response services were bid out for Key West Bight Marina and City Marina (Resolutions 08-069 and 08-075). Clean Harbor Environmental Services was the lowest responsive bidder. The contract with Clean Harbor Environmental Services allows for a two year extension with the same terms and conditions which they have agreed to.

#### PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION

Clean Harbor Environmental Services provides clean up services for large fuel or oil spills which we hope will never occur. This type of service was a perquisite for the "Clean Marina" designation and a good safety plan for the high speed fuel system at the ferry terminal.

#### **OPTIONS / ADVANTAGES / DISADVANTAGES:**

- 1. The City Commission can approve this 2-year contract extension with Clean Harbor Environmental Services.
- 2. The City can go out for RFP for oil spill cleanup services at Key West Bight and the City Marina @ Garrison Bight. This option is not recommended due to the fact that the contractor is maintaining the same pricing that was bid three years ago and the probability is that current pricing for all oil spill contractors
