## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT TO BOURBON STREET PUB, INC. FOR A NEW YEARS EVE SHOE DROP EVENT LOCATED AT 724 DUVAL STREET: PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 2:00 P.M. TO 12:30 A.M. ON TUESDAY, DECEMBER 31, 2024; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances requires a Special Event Permit to depart from the requirements of the City's Noise Control Ordinance; and

WHEREAS Bourbon Street Pub, Inc. has applied to the city for a Special Event Permit for their event "New Years Eve Shoe Drop" to take place on Tuesday, December 31, 2024, from 2:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.

WHEREAS Bourbon Street Pub, Inc. will be closing the 700 block of Duval Street, with a stage setup on the sidewalk at 724 Duval Street.

WHEREAS amplified music will be played during the event until 12:30 a.m.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable.

Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That Bourbon Street Pub, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the place and time as herein described.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
