Jim,

The City of Key West & State of Florida Flagship, the schooner *Western Union* is ready to proceed with the State of Florida, Dept. of State, preservation of the historic vessel.

The City of Key West generously provided \$250,000.00 matching funds that enabled application for the now approved \$500,000.00 SOF Preservation Grant to restore the historic *Western Union*

As part of the CKW \$250,000.00 funding it is agreed by signed covenant that the CKW & SOF Flagship, schooner *Western Union* shall remain home ported in the Historic Key West Bight, in her current slip.

Attached is an itemized list of repairs and items that are necessary to complete prior to motoring the schooner from Key West to the (MarPro) Tarpon Springs boatyard which is restoring the Flagship. The list also includes the transit expense of motoring the schooner to Tarpon. All work and the related budgeted expenditures are being monitored closely by the Schooner Western Union Preservation Society (SWUPS.)

As a result of the above, SWUPS is requesting \$40,000.00 of the CKW/SWU \$250,000.00 restoration matching funds approved by CKW Resolution 15-218 on June 17, 2015. The need of the funds is immediate and your attention and assistance with this request will be greatly appreciated, thank you.
