





#### Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

Officers were rendering aid and working a traffic crash when a white male, later identified as Casey Lourigan, began pestering them about applying a tourniquet (which was not necessary), and how an ambulance needed to respond (already in route). Officers gave commands to stay back several times, however Lourigan (who had not relation to the patient or those involved in the crash) continued to approach and yell commands. Officer Thornbrugh pushed Lourigan back and he tensed up, at which point he was taken to the ground and Officer Beerbower assisted in handcuffing the subject. He was charged with violation of the Halo law and resisting. He sustained only minor scrapes to his knee and no officers were injured.
