Design and Construction

- Spencer's Boat Yard Seawall Bid Let to LPS and Notice to proceed issued.
- Staples Ave Pedestrian Bridge Handrails received and installed. Final finish of asphalt and punch items remain. Bridge is open to the public.
- Smathers Beach Pavilions Pavilions 4,5,6,7 framed. Pavilions 1,2, and 3 foundations poured.
- **Eaton Street Resurface and Drainage** FKAA complete. City work will commence after Boat Races with final completion in January.
- **South Street improvements** 545 LF Sidewalk installed, 545 LF F- Curb installed, 4 ADA ramps installed, ② Catch Basins 4,5, and 6 set with all underground.
- Clinton Square Pocket Park Contractor is currently on schedule to complete NLT February 2025. Seat wall footings and walls themselves were formed, inspected, and poured. A few bulging issues are being resolved by the contractor identified after form removal.
- **John Jones Navigation Center** Building structure is erected and windows installed. Working changes/PRs to address power and sewer. Project remains on schedule for completion May 2025.
- **Firehouse 3** Structural assessment completed and repairs approval on agenda for this month
- Frederick Douglass Community Center Interior and exterior finishes in process.
 Project on schedule.
- Beach Restoration: Monitoring continues, no action levels met to date.
- Southernmost Point Plaza Progress has continued with design on the project with progress toward 60% design. BBC Engineering submitted a Master Plan for review.
 Master Plan is roughly 50% complete and City comments sent back. Final TDC DAC

- 1 Phase 2 Grant approval documents received from the Monroe County BOCC in the amount of \$1,501,302.00
- MLK Pool Quarterly Structural assessment was completed. The structure has a few items needing attention withing the year to maintain operation.
