TO 8:00 P.M; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF THE 700 & 800 BLOCKS OF DUVAL STREET DURING THE HOURS OF 10:00 A.M. TO 10:00 P.M; GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE NOISE CONTROL ORDINANCES PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 12:00 NOON TO 9:00 P.M; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN AN ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Key West Business Guild wishes to conduct a street fair for Womenfest on the day and during the hours stated above; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida;

SECTION 1. That the Key West Business Guild is hereby granted permission to conduct a Street Fair on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager; and that 25% of gross revenue or \$1000.00, whichever is greater, shall be donated to the Key West Business Guild Fund.

SECTION 2. That the Key West Business Guild is hereby granted permission for the closure of the 700 & 800 blocks of Duval Street on the date and during the hours stated above.

SECTION 3. That the Key West Business Guild is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 4. That the Key West Business Guild is hereby granted an exemption from

the sound control ordinance under section 6-86 of Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 5. That the Key West Business Guild will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West
