An application was received for the removal of one **(1) Gumbo Limbo** and one **(1) Wild Tamarind tree**. A site inspection was done on July 24, 2012 and documented the following:

Tree Species: Gumbo Limbo (*Bursea simaruba*)  
Wild Tamarind (*Lysiloma bahamensis*)





Diameter: Gumbo Limbo – 13.3”dbh  
Wild Tamarind – 14.5”dbh  
**Total = 27.8 dbh**

Location: 60% - both trees in fence area

Species: 100% - both trees on protected tree list

Condition: 80% - both trees in good health

Total Average Value = **80%**

Value x Diameter = replacement caliper (dbh) inches

80% x 27.8”dbh = **22.2 replacement caliper (dbh) inches**



Recommendations:      Staff recommends **approval** of the permit
