



-- Samantha Ann Schuman Arrest Narrative:

On Sunday, April 28th, 2024, at approximately 0017 hours, I (Officer Antonova) was dispatched to 8th Street and Seidenberg Avenue in reference to a stolen vehicle.

Multiple units were dispatched to look for a gold-colored Cadilac bearing Florida Tag RNR110 that was reported stolen by its owner, Bo Jesper.

Jesper reported that a female subject (later identified as Samantha Schuman) got in his car while he left it unattended for a few minutes, with a key in the ignition, and took off. Jesper said there was a witness on the scene (later identified as Anginio Valdez) who saw everything happen and was able to video-record Samantha driving away in the vehicle. i watched the video recording. In the video, i observed Samantha driving away in the stolen vehicle and saying "bye".

Jesper realized he had his iPad in the stolen car and was able to track the location of the car at 1503 Seminary Street. I responded to the address above.

Upon arrival, I observed Officer Thornbrugh, Officer T. Anglin, Officer Lopez, and Officer Hesse on the scene. They had Samantha in custody. I saw Samantha lying on the ground, handcuffed, actively resisting by refusing to calm down and follow the instructions that Officer Thornbrugh and other Officers on the scene were giving her. Samantha was yelling to let her go because she wanted to go home. I recognized Samantha from a previous call i had earlier tonight. Samantha was terspassed from Domestic Abuse Shelter but kept coming back and demanding to enter the structure. I was dispatched to the shelter three times to deal with Samantha.

Officer Thornbrugh explained that when he arrived on the scene, Samantha was sitting by the front door at 1503 Seminary Street. Samantha did not follow lawful commands and resisted by pulling away from Officer Thornbrugh. Samantha deliberately dug her nails into Officer Thornbrugh's arm and scratched him while he was trying to place her in handcuffs. Officer Thornbrugh drive stun Samantha with his Taser to gain compliance and handcuffed her. After she was handcuffed, Samantha grabbed Officer Thornbrugh's hand and tried to bend his fingers.

With the help of Officer Hesse, Samantha was placed into his patrol vehicle.

Samantha refused medical evaluation on scene and was transported by Officer Hesse to the Lower Keys Medical Center to get medically cleared.

I met the resident of 1503 Seminary Street, Libbie Meyer. Libbie stated this was not Samantha's first visit to Libbie's house. According to Libbie, Samantha had been seeing Libbie's roommate, Billy, for a few days now, and she had visited the residence before. Libbie said Samantha showed up tonight and entered the house through the front door that was not locked. Libbie asked Samantha to leave her house. Libbie pointed out to a window by the front door, which had a broken screen. Libbie said Samantha broke the window screen. Libbie did not want to press any charges against Samantha but did ask me to issue Samantha a trespass warning.

Shortly after arriving at the Lower Keys Medical Center, Samantha was medically cleared and transported to Monroe County Detention Center.

There was no known damage to the vehicle at the time of this report.

Due to the stated facts and evidence, I find probable cause that Samantha Schuman did knowingly and unlawfully obtain and use the property and did so to temporarily or permanently deprive the victim of the property contrary to

On April 28, 2024, at approximately 0015 hours, Ofc. Antonova was dispatched to the intersection of Seidenberg Avenue and 8th Street. The caller told key west dispatch his vehicle was stolen by a female driver. The caller told key west dispatch his vehicle was a gold colored Cadilac bearing Florida registration RNR110.

I. Ofc. Lopez informed over the radio; I was going to post my patrol vehicle on the outbound side of the Cow Key Channell Bridge in the event the driver attempted flee Key West. I placed my patrol vehicle at the above-mentioned location for a few minutes and I did not observe a vehicle matching the description.

Ofc. Thornbrough advised over the radio that he had visual contact of the vehicle near the 1500 block of Seminary Street.

I responded to the 1500 block of Seminary Street to assist the officers on scene. I observed the reported stolen vehicle parked on the side of the road. The vehicle was facing west.

Ofc. Thornbrough advised over the radio the registered owner of the vehicle gave the officers consent to search the vehicle.

I began searching the vehicle and shortly after I completed it. I did not see any visible signs of damage inside the vehicle. I observed the armrest cover from the center console laying down on the front passenger seat. I located U.S. currency inside the center console and also underneath the driver's floorboard. I picked up the U.S. currency and placed it on the front driver seat.

The reporting party, vehicle owner responded on scene. The vehicle owner was identified with his Florida driver's license as Bo Jesper Wendels Ek, (dob:08/04/1967).

Bo Jesper was instructed to inspect his vehicle in the event he had missing, damaged property. I told Bo Jesper I noticed the armrest cover was laying down on the front passenger seat and he informed me he had knowledge of it. I informed Bo Jesper I found U.S. currency inside the center console and underneath the floorboard. Bo Jesper did not report to me if he had missing, damaged property.

Hesse, was dispatched with multiple officers to the report of a stolen vehicle from the area of 8th St and Seidenberg Ave. The vehicle was located a short time later near 1503 Seminary St and Samantha Shuman was placed into custody by Ofc. Thornbrugh. See Ofc. Thornbrugh's supplemental report and Ofc. Antonova's case report for greater details.

Shuman was secured into my patrol vehicle following her arrest with the rear Axon camera activated. While assisting with the investigation, I spoke with Aigul Aliyeva who witnessed part of the event. Aliyeva told me she observed the stolen tan Cadillac SUV pull up in front of 1503 Seminary St and stop, stating the vehicle drove up very quickly with the flashers on.

Aliyeva told me the female driver and sole occupant stepped out wearing a blue "tank top" and blue jeans. She told me the female, who's description matched Shuman's exactly, walked away from the vehicle swearing and appeared very angry to the west. Aliyeva stated she did not witness any other part of the incident and returned outside to find numerous police vehicles in the area.

Rescue arrived around that time, and I returned to my vehicle to allow EMS access to evaluate Shuman. It was at that time that Shuman was found to have slipped out of both handcuffs and was unrestrained in the rear of my vehicle. Shuman was removed from the vehicle by me and Ofc. T. Anglin and I applied handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and double locked. Shuman was then resecured into my vehicle and transported to LKMC for medical clearance prior to being lodged at the jail.

Following medical clearance, I transported Shuman to the MCSO jail where she was lodged by Ofc. Antonova. See Ofc. Antonova's case report for greater details.

This concluded my involvement in the investigation.

On 04/28/2024, at approximately 0015 hours, I Officer Thornbrugh, was notified by dispatch to be on the lookout for a stolen Cadillac with Five 6's decals on the vehicle. I was informed the vehicle was last seen inbound on Flagler Avenue with a female subject as the driver. I dealt with the subject earlier in the day for a trespassing at 1623 Spaulding Ct.

I was notified by dispatch the victim's iPad was inside the vehicle and was pinging at 1513 Seminary St. I responded and observed the stole vehicle parked in front of 1503 Seminary St; the vehicles hazards were actively flashing. I exited from my patrol vehicle and unholstered my weapon, as I was visually clearing the vehicle I observed the female subject, sitting on the porch of 1503 Seminary St. I ordered the subject to exit the property with her hands up, the subject approached me quickly while flailing her hands. I removed the subject's purse off her shoulder to place her into handcuffs, as I grabbed the subject's arm, she dug her nails into my arm and pulled away from my grasps. I placed my taser on the stomach of the subject, as she was actively resisting and delivered a 1-2 second drive stun. As the subject fell to the ground K9 Officer T. Anglin arrived with K9 Jigsaw. Ofc. T. Anglin and I were giving loud verbal commands to stop resisting and instructed the female subject to place her hands behind her back. Officer Golovanov responded and was able to place handcuffs on the subject.

Ofc. Golovanov and I escorted the subject to Officer Hesse's patrol vehicle, as we were escorting the subject she started to drop her weight and pull away from us. The subject was attempting to grab my fingers and tried to bend them during the escort. The suspect was placed into the patrol vehicle without further incident.

I have no further involvement in this case.

On 28APR24 at 0019, I (Ofc. T. ANGLIN) responded to the area of 1st Street and Flagler Avenue to assist responding units in canvassing the area for a stolen vehicle. KWPD Dispatch advised that a gold 2008 Cadillac utility vehicle, (FL Tag# RNR110), which was licensed as a taxi, was stolen moments ago by a female fare, from the intersection of 8th street and Seidenberg Avenue. Ofc. M. BEERBOWER met with the victim, who stated he last saw the female suspect, later identified as SAMATHA SCHUMAN drive the Cadillac west onto Flagler Avenue. The victim also stated that the female was white and wearing a blue and white polka dotted shirt.

While canvassing the Flagler Avenue and numerous side streets, Ofc. M. BEERBOWER advised via two-way radio that the victim had an active I Pad inside the Cadillac and it was pinging on the 1500 block of Seminary Street.

Ofc. E. THORNBRUGH and I arrived on the 1500 block of Seminary Street. Ofc. E. THORNBRUGH observed the Cadillac parked on the north side of the street, facing west and with it's hazard lights flashing, (Unoccupied). As I exited my patrol vehicle, I could hear Ofc. E. THRONBRUGH giving commands, but I was unable to see him due to the poor lighting conditions on the sidewalk behind several parked vehicles on the north side of the street.

I affixed a six-foot nylon lead to the nylon harness K-9 JIGSAW was wearing and retrieved him from the rear of my patrol vehicle. I rapidly approached the parked cars on the north side of the street and as I rounded the front of a parked car, I immediately observed Ofc. E. THORNBRUGH with his Taser in his hand giving commands to SAMANTHA SCHUMAN, who was flailing around on the ground and screaming, (See supplemental reports for details). I maintained a close overwatch position with K-9 JIGSAW and gave commands for SCHUMAN to cease her resistance or the K-9 would be deployed.

SCHUMAN continued to flail and scream as and Ofc. I. GOLOVANOV handcuffed her. As SCHUMAN was being handcuffed, I observed K-9 JIGSAW begin focusing away from SCHUMAN and towards the adjacent residence. After several seconds, I observed a female, who was holding a baseball bat, emerge from the darkness, (Female later identified as the homeowner). Once SCHUMAN was secured and the scene was safe, I secured K-9 JIGSAW in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

While on scene, Ofc. J. HESSE informed me that SCHUMAN, who was in the rear of his patrol vehicle, had managed to slip out of her handcuffs. I assisted Ofc. J. HESSE in handcuffing SCHUMAN and securing her in the rear of his patrol vehicle. The victim arrived on scene and took possession of his Cadillac, (See original report for details). I gathered information for my report and departed the scene.

AT no time did I interview SCHUMAN.

Both my Axon BWC and Fleet cameras were active during this incident.
