Original Narrative By Danielle Fasulo, 12/26/25 00:00

On December 25, 2025, at approximately 2127 hours, Ofc Ua and I (Ofc. Fasulo) responded to Caroline Street and Simonton Street in reference to a male subject punching and damaging an Uber driver's vehicle.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Vanderhoof, Ofc. Floryance and Ofc. Osborne were already on scene. The Uber Driver was identified as Wilcharlson Appolon (FL DL A145880963310). Wilcharlson told the officers on scene he was stopped in front of the Bull and Whistle Bar located at 224 Duval Street by an unknown male waving money in his hand demanding an Uber ride. Wilcharlson said to the subject he cannot accept cash as payment, and he must book a ride through the Uber App. The subject appeared to be intoxicated and became extremely angry and began pounding and punching the hood of Wilcharlson's red Kia SUV bearing FL tag CH6BG. This incident was witnessed by two bystanders identified as Denise Lahr (FL DL L600544658351) and Michael Hrabosky (FL DL H612550952480).

The male subject was later identified as Stephen Stritt (FL DL S363780860450) on Caroline Street by officers on scene.

Ofc. Vanderhoof and Ofc. Floryance placed Stephen in handcuffs and escorted him to the front of his patrol car to be searched for contraband and weapons. While in front of the patrol car, Stephen kicked Ofc. Floryance and began to tense up and pull away. Stephen had bloodshot eyes and the smell of alcohol emanated from his breath. After the search concluded, Stephen was escorted to the back of Ofc. Ua's patrol car where he tensed up and refused to get into the patrol vehicle. Stephen was noncompliant when told to have seat in the patrol vehicle and began to kick Ofc Vanderhoof and Ofc Floryance. At this time, Ofc. Vanderhoof drive stunned Stephen 2 times. After the drive stun, Ofc. Ua was able to shut the door to the patrol vehicle. While in the back of Ofc. Ua's patrol car, Stephen kicked the doors and seats and headbutted the window and cage-divider to the front seats. Sergeant Miller was notified and arrived on scene at 2137 hours and conducted a Response to Resistance Incident of Stephen.

Ofc. Ua and I transported Stephen to the Lower Keys Medical Center for medical clearance at 2144 hours. Stephen was cleared by the medical staff at 2217 hours.

Ofc. Ua and I arrived at Monroe County Detention Center with Stephen at 2224 hours. While Ofc. Ua attempted to escort Stephen to the elevator, he refused to comply with his verbal commands. Stephen began to pull away and walked away from Ofc. Ua's control. Ofc. Ua conducted a takedown at 2227 hours of Stephen due to his refusal to comply with his commands. The time of the takedown was confirmed with the security cameras within the sally port at the corrections facility. After the take down, I contacted the jail staff for assistance. Corrections staff escorted Stephen to intake processing. Stephen continued to act belligerent towards the jail staff and refused to comply with their verbal commands. Stephen resisted corrections officers after being commanded to comply with medical staff during intake by tensing and pulling away. Correction Deputy Jonathan Guerra physically restrained and took down Stephen onto the ground and was drive stunned and pepper sprayed by corrections Sergeant at 2239 hours. Stephen was placed in the restraint chair.

My BWC 4565 and Fleet 5340 were activated during this incident. I took photos of the damage to Wilcharlson's Kia to document the damage. I uploaded my BWC footage and photos from Axon Capture to evidence.com. I handed Wilcharlson Appolon a Victim's Right Advocate Brochure.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I believe sufficient probable cause exists for the arrest of Stephen Stritt for violating FSS 806.13-1b3, Criminal Mischief 1000 Dollars or More. This is due to the fact that Stephen willfully and maliciously damaged the property belonging to another. There were multiple dents to the hood of the vehicle caused by Stephen punching the vehicle. The estimated cost to repair the damage is approximately \$1,500.00.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I believe sufficient probable cause exists for the arrest of Stephen Stritt for violating FSS 843.01 – Resisting an Officer with Violence. This is due to the fact that Stephen kicked Ofc. Floryance and Ofc Vanderhoof while being placed in the back of the patrol vehicle. Stephen is also being charged with a second count of resisting a Corrections Deputy Jonathan Guerra with violence due to the fact that he tensed and pulled away from the corrections officers resulting in being sprayed and drive stunned.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I believe sufficient probable cause exists for the arrest of Stephen Stritt for violating FSS 877.03 – Disorderly Conduct. This is due to the fact that Stephen was intoxicated and causing a disturbance by screaming loudly and using profanity, which corrupts public morals and outrages public decency. During this incident a crowd of people gathered around the vehicle obstructing pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

Supplemental Narrative By Corey Vanderhoof, 12/26/25 04:11

On Thursday 12/25/2025 at approximately 2114 hours, I (Ofc. Vanderhoof) was dispatched to 224 Duval St in reference to a possible physical altercation.

Upon arrival I was flagged down about a male in a white and orange shirt who was trying to fight an Uber driver. The person who flagged me down informed me that the male had gone east on Caroline St.

Ofc. Osborne and I made contact with a male matching the description near the intersection of Caroline St and Ann St.

The suspect, identified as Stephen Stritt (Arrestee), put his hands in the air and sat on a curb on the sidewalk. I asked

Stritt about the incident and he continuously told me that he had no idea why I was there and what was going on.

After all of us on scene were able to figure out what had happened from witnesses and the victim, we placed Stritt in handcuffs.

While escorting Stritt to Ofc. Ua's patrol vehicle he became combative and refused to walk. While searching Stritt he kicked Ofc. Floryance and I. While trying to place Stritt in the patrol vehicle he refused to get in. Stritt was warned numerous times that he would be drive stunned if he refused to get in the vehicle. Stritt continued to refuse to get in. I provided an arch warning and again instructed Stritt to get in the vehicle. Stritt refused again. I drive stunned Stritt on the left side of his abdomen until I gained compliance. Stritt leaned back into the patrol vehicle with his legs still outside of the vehicle. Stritt began kicking me again. I drive stunned Stritt again, this time in his left leg until I gained compliance.

Stritt eventually entered the vehicle where he began kicking and hitting his head against the interior of Ofc. Ua's vehicle.

My BWC was active for the encounter and uploaded to Evidence.com.
