A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "QUIT CLAIM DEED" (PARCEL NO. 169), TO TRANSFER NECESSARY RIGHT-OF WAY ALONG STATE ROAD NO. 5, NORTH ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD, TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 7.03(a) OF THE CITY CHARTER; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requires certain portions of right-of-way at two locations within Parcel 169 to facilitate the installation of High Intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) pedestrian beacons along North Roosevelt Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approval of the attached Quitclaim Deed, to assign Parcel 169 to FDOT to facilitate the installation of HAWK crosswalks, and to additionally transfer liability and responsibility for maintenance of certain portions the North Roosevelt Boulevard promenade to FDOT; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Quit Claim Deed" (Parcel No. 169) is approved, pursuant to Section 7.03(a) of the City Charter.

Section 2: That the Mayor or City Manager, where appropriate, is authorized to execute and submit all necessary documents upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
