I'm concerned about Item #12 regarding Bayview Park. The new plan presented on March 26, 2025, was not on the agenda and bypasses years of public input. It eliminates the splash pad, shifts focus to artificial turf (not previously prioritized), and uses the entire \$1M budget on turf alone.

Key infrastructure issues like drainage and field amenities are ignored, and the contractor's list of exclusions exposes the city to significant unforeseen costs.
