A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT IN SHOULTON TYLER VS. THE CITY OF KEY WEST, WORKER'S COMPENSATION CASE NO. OJCC11-4394CMH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS CONSISTENT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Key West, was fully advised of the instant worker's compensation litigation in the matter of Shoulton Tyler vs. The City of Key West, and deliberated its options.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission of the City of Key West agrees to the terms and conditions as negotiated by the City Attorney's Office at a mediation in the Case of Shoulton Tyler vs. The City of Key West that took place on January 21, 2014 in an amount not to exceed \$125,000.00 inclusive of all fees and costs, and authorizes the City Manager to execute all documents consistent therewith.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
