

RESOLUTION NO. 12-266

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING TASK ORDER 7-12 PORTS TO CH2M HILL FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN AND PREPARATION OF BID DOCUMENTS FOR MOLE PIER FLOATING DOCK AND FUELING STATION IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$49,350.00; APPROVING NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West leases from the United States of America through the Department of the Navy a section of the Navy Outer Mole Pier for the specific purpose of cruise ship berthing; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent payments to the Navy for use of the Mole Pier, the City has agreed to perform certain in-kind projects, including the work contemplated in Task Order 7-12 Ports; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this project will be covered as an in-kind service through the Navy Mole Lease funds; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 07-331, the City Commission approved a three-year contract with CH2M Hill, Inc. for General Engineering Services and in Resolution No. 10-287 the contract was extended for an additional two years; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Task Order 7-12 Ports to CH2M HILL is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$49,350.00 for the design and preparation of bid documents for Mole Pier Floating Dock and Fueling Station.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any contractual documents, with the advice and consent of the City Attorney, that are consistent with Task Order 7-12 Ports and the approval granted herein.

Section 3: That necessary budget transfers from Navy Reserves Account #602-1900-519-9800 to Navy Repairs and Maintenance Account #602-1900-519-4600 to fund project number OM 1207 are hereby approved.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

RE: **Approval of a Task Order 7-12 Ports from CH2M Hill in the Amount of \$49,350 for Engineering Services for the Design and Preparation of Bid Documents for Mole Pier Floating Dock and Fueling Station.**

ACTION STATEMENT:

This resolution will approve Task Order 7-12-Ports from CH2M Hill in the amount of \$49,350 for engineering services for the Design and Preparation of Bid Documents for Mole Pier Floating Dock and Fueling Station.

The agreement will be executed pursuant to F.S. 287.055 (CCNA), City Code 2-841, and the City's contract with CH2M Hill approved by Resolution # 07-331 and extended and amended through Resolution 10-287.

BACKGROUND:

In lieu of rent payments to the Navy for the use of the Mole pier, the CITY has agreed to perform certain In-Kind Projects. Task Order 7-12-Ports Mole Pier Floating Dock and Fueling Station was requested by the Navy as indicated in the attached In-Kind request letter.

The proposed cost for this project submitted by CH2M Hill is within the Not-to-Exceed budget as specified by the Navy's In-Kind request letter.

M E M O R A N D U M

PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION

This project is in conformance with the Lease Agreement N62467-03-RP-00077 between the City and the U.S. Navy as approved by Resolution 03-138 and has been requested by the Navy via In-Kind Letter approving Ser PR712/786 dated 6 March 2012..

OPTIONS:

1. The City Commission can award the task order to CH2M Hill and proceed with the Mole Pier Fueling Station and Floating Dock design project.
2. The City Commission can decline the task order from CH2M Hill. This option is not recommended by Staff, as the City will be denying the Navy previously agreed-upon services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Budget Transfer: Funds in the amount of \$49,350 will be moved from the Navy Reserves Account #602-1900-519-9800 to Navy Repairs and Maintenance Account #602-1900-519-4600 and used to fund project number OM1207.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Commission select option 1, approving task order 7-12-Ports from CH2M Hill in the amount of \$49,350 for the engineering services for the Design and Preparation of Bid Documents for Mole Pier Floating Dock and Fueling Station.
