

RESOLUTION NO. 22-141

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "KEY WEST TRANSIT SOFTWARE AS A SERVICE DEPLOYMENT SERVICE ORDER" FOR ON-DEMAND TRANSIT SOFTWARE AS A SERVICE (SaaS), IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$248,880.00 AS DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED PRICE QUOTE FROM VIA TRANSPORTATION, INC. PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(4) (b) EXEMPT CONTRACTUAL SERVICES, BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the procurement of On-Demand Transit Software as a Service from Via Transportation, Inc. in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(4) provides that if exceptional circumstances exist to exempt a purchase from competitive bid requirements for the best interests of the city, the City Manager shall place a resolution before the city commission for approval of such exemption; and

WHEREAS, City staff anticipates the award of federal grant funding under the "Enhancing Mobility Innovation Program," which would provide funding of up to \$250,000 (City 20% match), which will cover up to 80% of the cost of this pilot project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Key West Transit Software as a Service Deployment Service Order" between the City and Via Transportation, is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$248,880.00, pursuant to Code of Ordinances Section 2-797(4), best interests of the City.

Section 2: This purchase will be funded with anticipated Federal Grant Funding through the "Enhancing Mobility Innovation Program" in an amount of up to \$250,000.00. Such funding will be matched up to 20% using the FY22 budget allocation for on-demand transit in the amount of \$45,000.00, and supplemental funding as necessary from the Transit Alternative Fund.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents on behalf of the City of Key West.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
