A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(4)b OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE APPROVAL OF A TASK ORDER FROM GOVERNMENT SERVICES GROUP, INC. (GSG) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,314.00 FOR STORMWATER AND SOLID WASTE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM TRANSITIONAL SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission has directed staff to work to transition the method of collecting stormwater and solid waste revenues from monthly billing to non-ad valorem assessments on the property tax roll; and

WHEREAS, City staff, upon advice of the Monroe County Tax Assessor, recommends the use of Government Service Group, Inc. (GSG) during the transition process, to serve the best interests of the City and ensure that the new billing process on the property tax roll is properly implemented in compliance with state statutes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a task order from GSG in an amount not to exceed \$54,314.00 is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That competitive bidding is waived in the best interests of the City, pursuant to section 2-797(4)b of the Code of Ordinances.

Section 3: That necessary budget funds are allocated in the FY 2013 budget from the stormwater utility fund (402) in the total amount of \$27,325.00 and the solid waste utility fund (403) in the total amount of \$26,989.00.

Section 4: That the City Manager, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Key West an agreement in substantial conformance with the attached proposal and Appendix A.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
