(GSG) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,314.00 FOR STORMWATER ASSESSMENT PROGRAM WASTE SOLID FOR AN PROVIDING SERVICES; TRANSITIONAL EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission has directed staff to work to transition the method of collecting stormwater and solid waste revenues from monthly billing to non-ad valorum assessments on the property tax roll; and

WHEREAS, City staff, upon advice of the Monroe County Tax Assessor, recommends the use of Government Service Group, Inc. (GSG) during the transition process, to serve the best interests of the City and ensure that the new billing process on the property tax roll is properly implemented in compliance with state statutes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a task order from GSG in an amount not to exceed \$54,314.00 is hereby authorized.

in the total amount of \$26,989.00.

of the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of
the City of Key West an agreement in substantial conformance with
the attached proposal and Appendix A.
Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect
