## Narrative

**NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT**

Officers responded to a report of a male stealing a scooter from a parking space. Officers Gruba and Torrecillas arrived and met with the subject on the sidewalk. The subject acted erratically, arguing aggressively with an unknown older male and female.

The subject started yelling at Ofc. Gruba and Officer Torrecillas. They asked the subject to stop screaming, and he just screamed louder. The subject's behavior became aggressive, and he refused to comply with Officer Gruba's verbal commands to step back. He continued stepping closer to Officer Gruba. The Officers attempted to take him into custody, but he pulled away from them and turned his body to prevent them from placing him in handcuffs.

He was taken to the ground, where he continued to resist the officer's orders to put his hands behind his back. During the takedown of the subject, Officer Gruba received minor lacerations to both of his knees and three of his right-hand fingers.

The subject was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center, where he was medically cleared.

I photographed the subject, and he did not complain of any injuries. Officer Gruba was treated for his minor injuries.

-- Oaklen Micheal Jenkins Arrest Narrative:

On August 15, 2024, at approximately 2122 hours, I, Officer J. Torrecillas responded to 912 Duval St. reference a report of a mental health issue. Dispatch advised there was a male sitting on the steps, and the reporting person advised he was trying to steal someone's moped.

Upon arrival, there were several bystanders pointing to a male that was engaged in a confrontation with another male. The male matched the description provided by dispatch. The male, later identified as Oaklen Jenkins (arrestee), was arguing with another male (unidentified), who had his hands up and not engaging.

Officer J. Gruba and I separated Jenkins and the male. Ofc. Gruba told Jenkins to sit on the steps several times and Jenkins refused. Jenkins' behavior was erratic, and he kept yelling. Ofc. Gruba and I asked Jenkins to stop yelling, and he began yelling louder. Jenkins' behavior became aggressive, therefore Ofc. Gruba and I attempted to handcuff Jenkins. Jenkins pulled his arms away from us and turned his body to prevent us from placing him in handcuffs. Ofc. Gruba and I directed Jenkins to the ground where I took control of his right arm and Ofc. Gruba his left. Ofc. Gruba applied the handcuffs. We stood Jenkins up and Ofc. Gruba, Ofc. D. Christina, and I escorted him to Ofc. Gruba's patrol car, we searched him, and placed him in the back seat.

Ofc. Gruba sustained lacerations to four fingers on his right hand, left wrist, and both knees.

I was flagged down by two juveniles who stated they witnessed the incident. The juveniles were identified as [REDACTED] (witness) and [REDACTED] (witness) and [REDACTED] stated the following:

They saw Jenkins in the driver seat of a car. Jenkins and the other male were fighting. It appeared as though the other male was trying to get Jenkins out of the car. The male got Jenkins out of the car and drove off. Jenkins then walked over to a scooter that was parked legally in the parking lane and pushed in onto the sidewalk. Jenkins tried to start the scooter but dropped it several times. The renter of the scooter arrived and told Jenkins it was his scooter. Jenkins argued it was not, and the renter told him he had the key. The renter told Jenkins he was going to prove it to him by lifting the seat. When he walked up to the scooter, he pretended to open the seat, shoved Jenkins away from him using the back of his arm and drove off on the scooter. Jenkins then grabbed [REDACTED] in a headlock, but [REDACTED] was able to free himself. Jenkins then engaged with the male (which I saw when I arrived).

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated Jenkins had sustained an injury to his head while he fought the male from the car. They pointed to a smear of blood on the sidewalk they stated came from Jenkins's head.

The scooter was no longer on scene and the only information we got at this time was that it was a rental scooter with a number 34, and it was possibly rented from Barefoot Billy's.

Ofc. Christina and I asked Louchheim and Hetu for a description of the vehicle. As they were explaining, they pointed out a vehicle driving South on Duval St. and stated that was the vehicle. Ofc. Christina and I stopped the vehicle. We spoke to the driver, identified as Andrei Kostychev (victim). Kostychev had scrapes and abrasions consistent with being in a physical altercation. Kostychev did not speak much English, therefore we communicated with him using a translator application. Additionally, I called Officer M. Brable to ask him if he spoke Russian. Ofc. Brable told me he did not, but the person he was with did; so, she helped with minimal translations as well.

Kostychev's statements were as follows:

He was driving with his windows down and a male (Jenkins) opened his car door and got in. Jenkins started fighting

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with him in the car. He did not know Jenkins, nor did he invite him into the car. He stopped the car and tried pulling Jenkins out of the car. Once Jenkins was out of the car, he got back in the driver's seat and drove away.

Kostychev refused medical attention and stated he wished to pursue charges.

Ofc. Christina took pictures of Kostychev's injuries, which he later sent to me.

The rental scooter will require further investigation to determine the r/o.

~~██████████~~ refused to pursue charges against Jenkins for battery.

It is worth noting, as I was conducting interviews, an unidentified male approached and stated Jenkins had tried to get into his car on Simonton St. as well. He stated Jenkins banged on his window and aggressively pulled the handles while yelling at him. The male did not remain on scene for me to speak to him.

Based on my investigation, I believe there is probable cause Oaklen Jenkins violated F.S.S. 810.02(2)(a), burglary, when he entered a conveyance, vehicle belonging to Andrei Kostychev, with the intent to commit an offense therein. In the course of committing the offense, Oaklen Jenkins committed a battery upon Andrei Kostychev.

I believe there is probable cause Oaklen Jenkins violated F.S.S. 843.02, resisting officer without violence to his or her person, when he attempted to defeat Ofc. Gruba and my attempt to handcuff him by pulling his arms away from us and refusing to obey lawful commands during the lawful execution of our legal duty.

I transported Jenkins to the Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room to be medically cleared. After being cleared, I transported Jenkins to the Monroe County Detention Center.

My BWC was activated and uploaded to evidence.com. My Axon Fleet in-car was activated and uploaded to evidence.com. All pictures were uploaded to evidence.com.
