A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING ISSUANCE OF TASK ORDER NO. 9 TO BLACK & CORPORATION VEATCH FOR **ENGINEERING** EVALUATION AND DESIGN SERVICES REPLACEMENT OF ACTIVATED SLUDGE PUMPS AT RICHARD A HEYMAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FACILITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$92,813.00; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE
