**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING BOARD OF CITY OF
KEY WEST RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY
COMMISSION APPROVE THE ATTACHED PROPOSED
ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE AN INCENTIVE FOR
PLANTING CANOPY TREES; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the Planning Board recognizes that the Tree Commission recommended approval of the attached proposed ordinance at its meeting of July 9, 2018, Resolution No. TC-18-001; and

WHEREAS, Section 110-331 of the Code of Ordinances provides a caliper requirement for replacement of certain trees, and the Tree Commission believes that adjusting the caliper requirement for canopy trees would encourage the planting of such trees; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board recommends City Commission approval of the attached proposed ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE PLANNING BOARD OF THE
CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:**

Section 1: That the Planning Board recommends that the City Commission approve the attached proposed ordinance, amending Section 110-331 of the Code of Ordinances, to adjust the caliper ratio to 4:1 as an incentive for planting canopy trees.






