**NOTES: This tree has bacterial wetwood on its bark. Common for this species. The tree has a narrow planter which matches its canopy. It is common for trees to grow better canopies on the side or sides where the roots can grow, absorb, transport and store energy. The tree is possibly maintained in this manner as well. The tree has numerous broken limbs and has a less-than-ideal planter/bed for its roots. That being said it looks good considering the lack of planning and care it receives.**
