A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE WE'VE GOT THE KEYS THE USE OF CITY PROPERTY AT 1405 DUVAL STREET FOR A KEY LIME FESTIVAL/WORLD PIE EATING CHAMPIONSHIP ON FRIDAY, JULY 4, 2025, FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M. (SET-UP BEGINNING AT 8:00 A.M.); AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, We've Got the Keys wishes to use the Southernmost Beach Café site located at 1405 Duval Street, Key West, Florida for a "Key Lime Festival/World Pie Eating Championship" to take place on Friday, July 4, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Set-up beginning at 8:00 a.m.); and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

Section 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

Section 3. That We've Got the Keys is hereby granted permission for the use of the Southernmost Beach Café site on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

Section 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Key West, Florida We've Got the Keys is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

Section 5. That We've Got the Keys must post the required notice regarding the prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of

age.

Section 6. That We've Got the Keys will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, and that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrel will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

Section 9. We've Got the Keys acknowledges they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

Section 10. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
