- **Plan Reviews:** 11


EMS Collections

Total EMS Revenue (October 1, 2024 – November 30, 2025): \$1,892,975.55

Training & Accomplishments

- Emergency Management staff met with representatives from the ARES/HAM Radio Club to assess their capabilities and infrastructure. We received a presentation about integrating their radio system into the City's EOC
- The Emergency Manager initiated the contract renewal process for the Disaster Response and Debris Removal Monitoring Services Contracts. These contracts are scheduled for renewal in 2026
- The Emergency Manager attended the South Florida Regional Planning Council meeting to participate in discussions regarding preparedness for large-scale public events in the region, including the upcoming FIFA World Cup.
- Two additionally firefighters successfully passed the National Paramedic Exam and are now registered State of Florida Paramedics. They have begun the KWFD Paramedic Sign Off Program under the supervision of Medical Director, Dr. Antionio Gandia, and will be fully operational upon successful completion.
