



# Monthly Key West Police Department Report

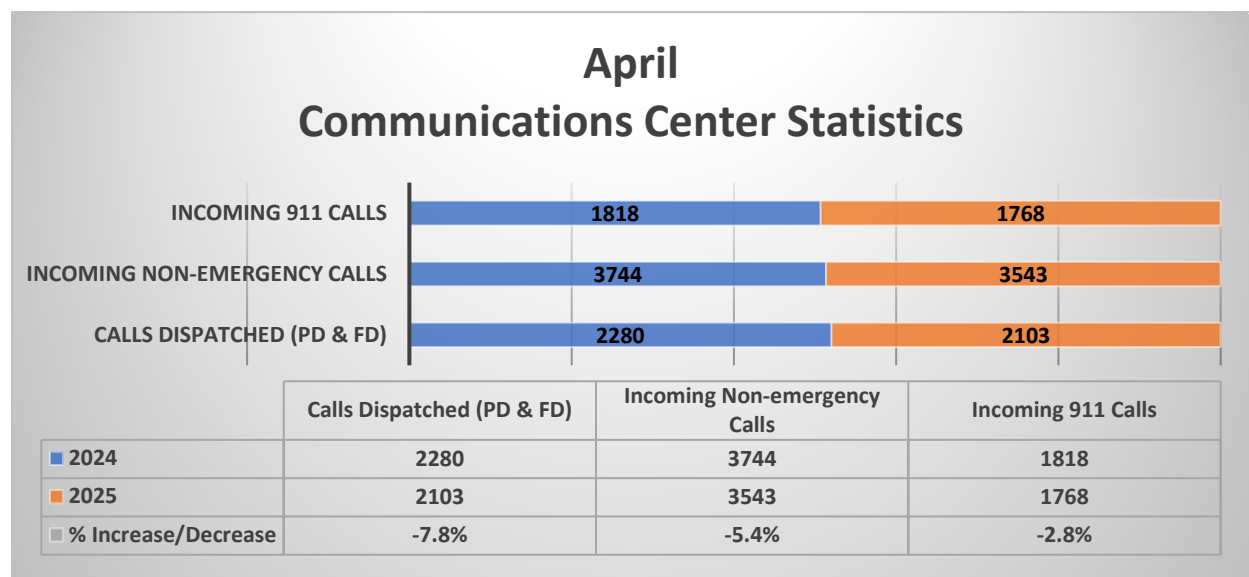
**Subject:** Monthly Report – April 2025

In April 2025, the Key West Police Department's Communication Center received 5,311 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,768 came directly to 911. Those calls generated 2,103 calls for service for police/fire/rescue. Compared to April 2024, we experienced a 2.8% decrease in 911 calls, a 5.4% decrease in non-emergency calls, and a 8.1% decrease in calls for service for police/fire/rescue.

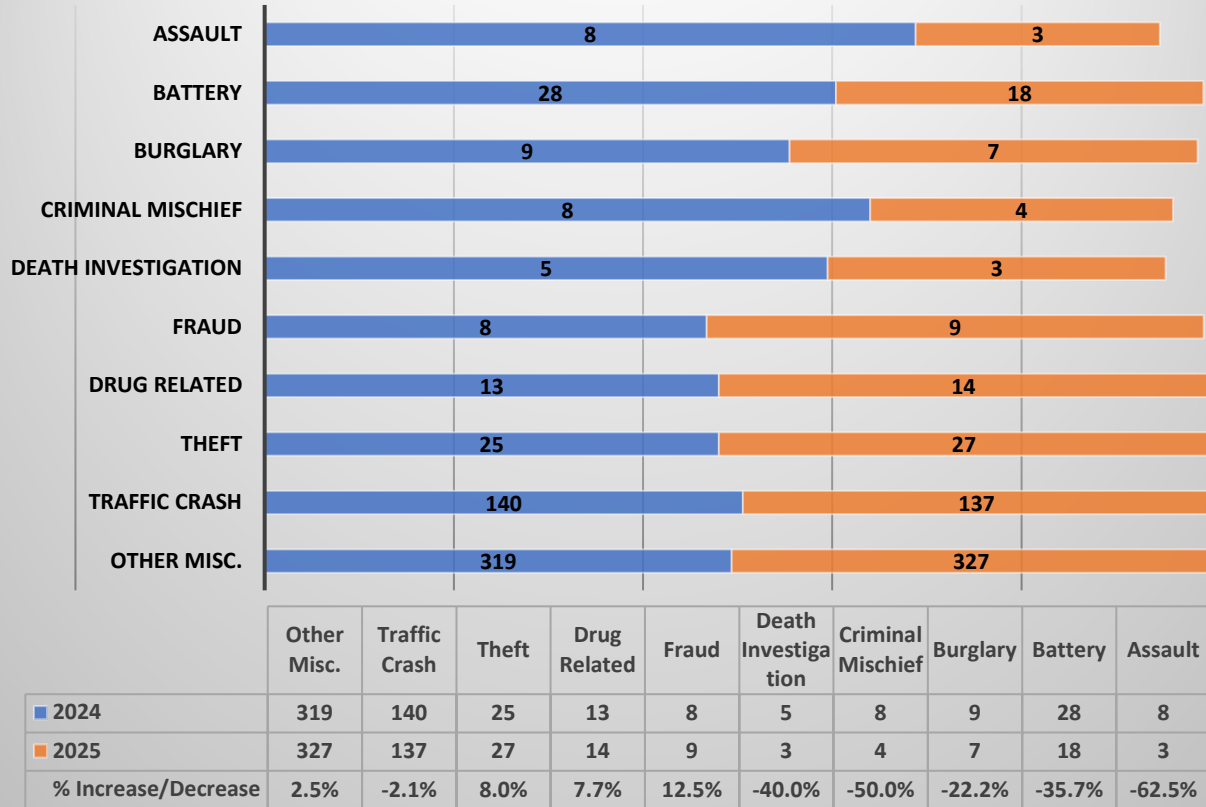
Officers completed 553 police reports and 132 arrests were made. Compared to April 2024, police reports decreased by 1.8% and arrests decreased by 9.6%.

A total of 2,523 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 396 citations and 408 written warnings.

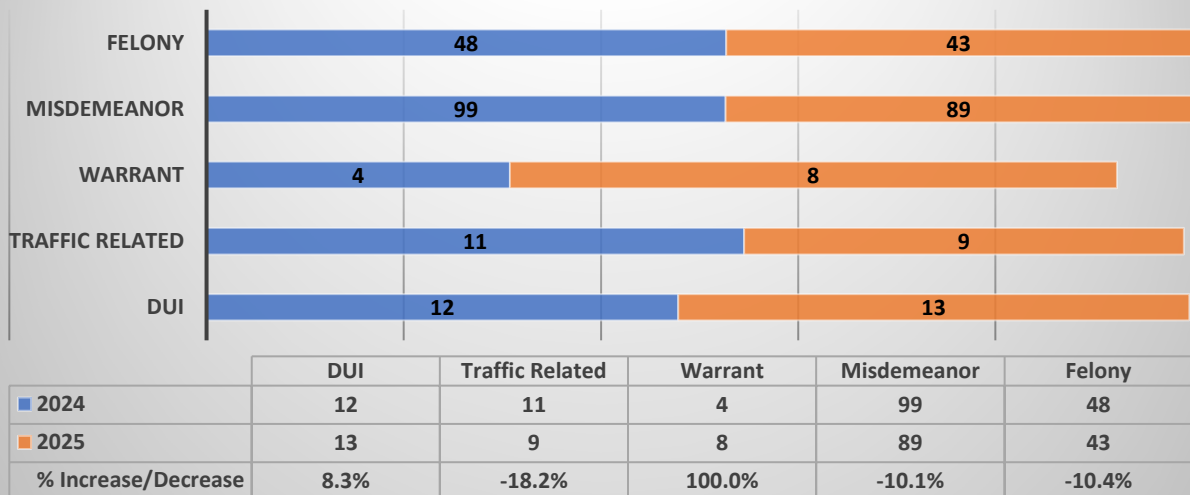

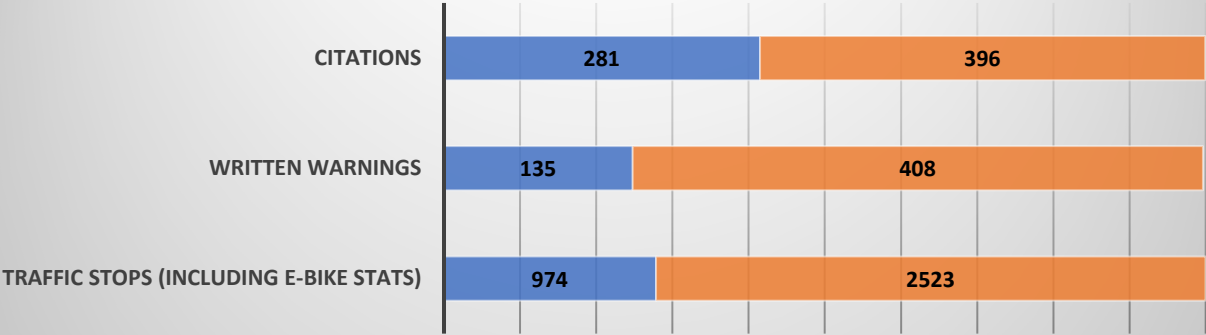
