## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE OPENING OF CEMETERY GATES ON FRANCIS STREET; PROVIDING CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, numerous residents and visitors peacefully make their way through the Key West Cemetery for a variety of purposes.

WHEREAS, the recent closure of the gates on Francis Street has disrupted and limited citizens' access to the Cemetery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That except as provided below, the Cemetery gates on Francis Street shall remain open in conjunction with the opening and closing of the Cemetery.

Section 2: That the gates may be closed at the direction of the Sexton during funeral services. In such event, the City Manager or his designee shall cause signs to be posted indicating that a service is in progress and specifying the expected time the gates will reopen.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall go into effect

immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the
signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
