A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) WACKER NEUSON GI30 MOBILE GENERATOR WITH RELATED ACCESSORIES IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$99,980.00 FROM KELLY TRACTOR CO., THROUGH PIGGYBACKING ON THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION AND FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES BID NO. FSA20-EQU18.0, HEAVY EQUIPMENT CONTRACT, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR USE AT FIRE STATION 3; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, this purchase will be made under the Florida Sheriffs Association and Florida Association of Counties Bid No. FSA20-EQU18.0 Contract, pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of one (1) Wacker Neuson G130 Generator and related accessories as described in the attached proposal of Kelly Tractor Co., pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances, under the Florida Sheriff's Association and Florida Association of Counties FSA20-EQU18.0 Heavy Equipment Contract, in a total amount not to exceed \$99,980.00, is hereby authorized for purchase and use at Fire Station Three.

Section 2: That funds for the purchase of this equipment will be allocated from funding under the American Rescue Plan Act and transferred to the Infrastructure/Fire/Machinery and Equipment Account 001-2201-522-6400 (\$99,980.00). Any related and necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
