A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DESIGN TASK ORDER FROM JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,124 FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN EFFORT FOR THE DESIGN, PERMITTING, AND BID PHASE SUPPORT FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE EFFLUENT PUMPS AND MANIFOLD AT THE RICHARD A. HEYMAN WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, BUDGET TRANSFERS OR AMENDMENTS WITHIN THE SEWER FUND, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West owns, operates and maintains the Richard A Heyman Environmental Protection Facility; and

WHEREAS, when the facility was constructed in 1989, two pumps were installed and both pumps are necessary to meet the redundancy requirement of Rule 62-600.300(2) (b), F.A.C.; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the two (2) originally installed effluent pumps is required to maintain operation of the effluent disposal system and remain in compliance with the State of Florida Domestic Wastewater Facility Permit, FLA147222; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 25-142 awarded Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. the design, bid and construction phase services contract for effluent pump replacement; and

WHEREAS, direct replacement pumps were no longer manufactured requiring additional design effort to select compatible pump equipment; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-841. *Contracts for Professional Services.* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West, Florida authorizes procurement of professional engineering services;

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approval of the attached design amendment for completion of the design, permitting, bid phase and construction engineering and inspection (CEI) services for the replacement of two (2) effluent pumps and manifold system at the Richard A. Heyman Environmental Protection Facility, in an amount not to exceed \$40,124, a 19.2% increase, bringing the task order total to \$249,238.00 and requiring approval of a budget transfer within the sewer fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Commission hereby approves the amendment to the design task order for professional engineering services from Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc., as attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the design, permitting, bid phase and construction engineering and inspection (CEI) services for the replacement of two (2) effluent pumps and manifold system at the Richard A. Heyman Environmental Protection Facility in an amount not to exceed \$40,124.00 to be paid from Account #4013504-5356500 *Construction in Progress*, Project Number SE35042501, upon authorization and completion of any necessary budget transfers within the Sewer Fund.

Section 2. That the Commission hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any necessary related documents and budget transfers/adjustments within the Sewer Fund, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
