A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "TROPICAL STORM/HURRICANE PARKING AGREEMENT" BETWEEN THE CITY AND MONROE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (MCSO) FOR TROPICAL STORM/HURRICANE PARKING FOR UP TO 30 VEHICLES AT 5701 COLLEGE ROAD; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the city owns certain property located at 5701 College Road, which is substantially higher in elevation than neighboring areas, including the area used by the MCSO to park law enforcement, emergency response and support personnel vehicles; and

WHEREAS, in the event of severe weather events, which may bring flooding, the City and the Sheriff's Department agree that it is in the best interests of both parties to arrange for parking at a higher elevation, to preserve the investment of public funds, and ensure that emergency vehicles remain in working order during and after major storms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "TROPICAL STORM/HURRICANE PARKING AGREEMENT" is hereby approved.
