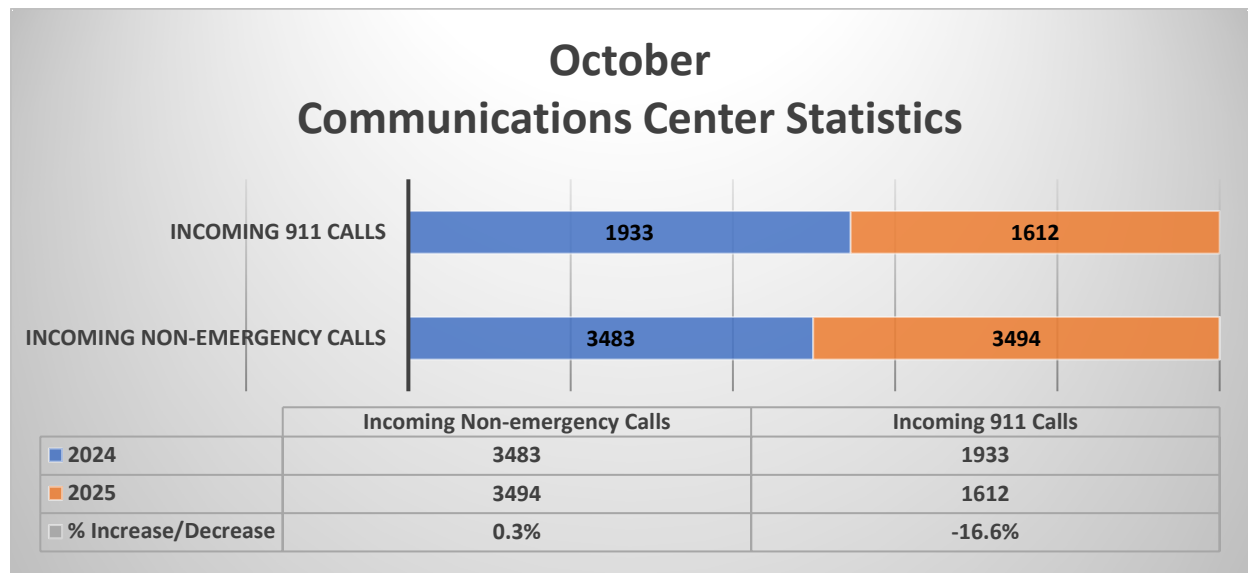
Subject: Monthly Report – October 2025

In October 2025, the Key West Police Department's Communication Center received 5,106 calls into the dispatch center. Of those calls, 1,612 came directly to 911. Compared to October 2024, we experienced a 16.6% decrease in 911 calls, and a 0.3% increase in non-emergency calls.

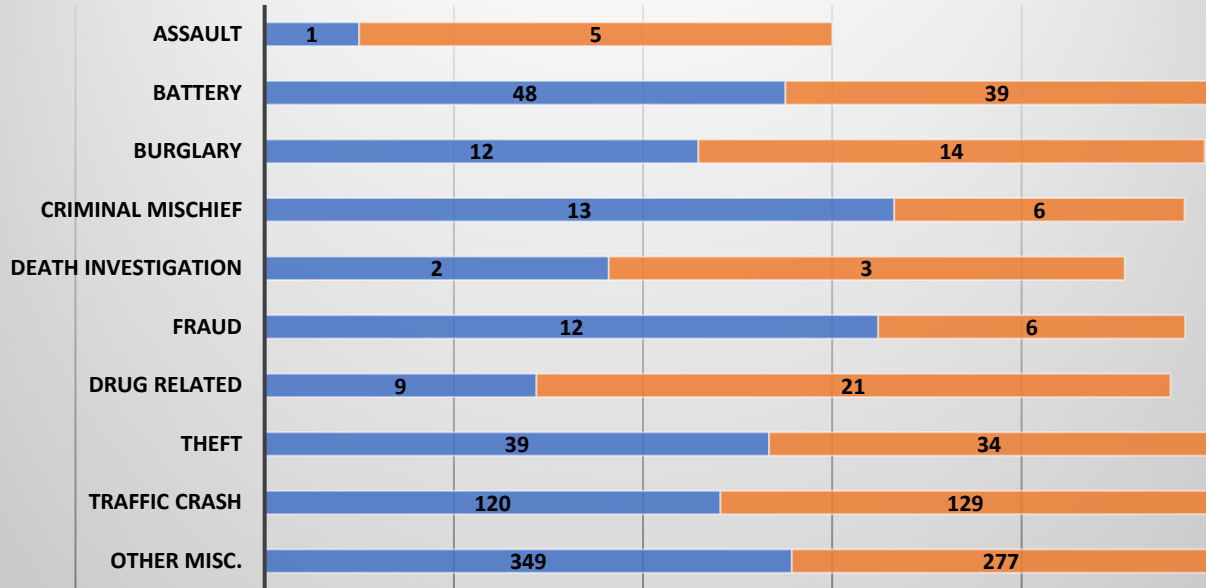
Officers completed 534 police reports and 165 arrests were made. Compared to October 2024, police reports decreased by 11.6% and arrests increased by 3.1%.

A total of 1,069 traffic stops (including e-bikes, stand-up scooters, bicycles, golf carts) were conducted. We issued 244 citations and 229 written warnings.

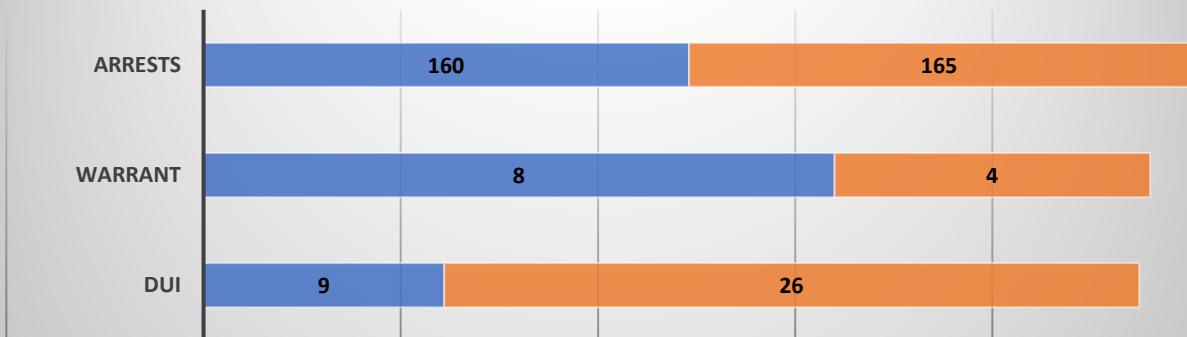

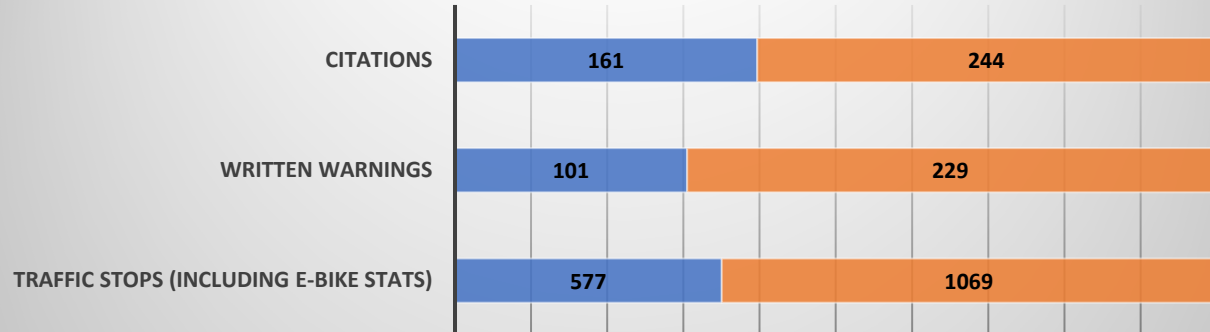
