A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING MIGRATION OF THE KEY WEST POLICE DEPARTMENT'S SOFTWARE APPLICATIONS TO THE ONESOLUTION SOFTWARE PLATFORM; AUTHORIZING ON A SOLE SOURCE BASIS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY SECTION 2-797(1), AND SECTION 797(4)(b), BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY, THE PURCHASE OF SUNGUARD ONESOLUTION PUBLIC SAFETY SOFTWARE IN AN INITIAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$587,730.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City staff has identified a need to replace/migrate the software applications used for public safety for Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Records Management Software (RMS) and Mobile Field Reporting and related purposes; and

WHEREAS, staff researched vendors, hosted demonstration sessions from two vendors, and determined that the package offered by SunGard ONESolution is the most responsive, accessible and user-friendly software platform for the staff and residents of the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(1) permits the purchase of goods and services without competition on a sole source basis under certain specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(4)(b) further provides "If in the opinion of the city manager exceptional circumstances exist to exempt a purchase from the competitive bid requirements of this subdivision for the best interests of the

city, he shall place a resolution before the city commission for approval of such exemption."; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended the waiver of formal bidding procedures pursuant to section 2-797(4) of the Code of Ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of the Sungard ONESolution Public Safety Platform at an initial cost not to exceed \$587,730.00 (exclusive of the annual maintenance fee and travel expenses), is hereby approved on a sole source basis, and in the best interest of the City, pursuant to sections 2-797(1) and 2-797(4), of the Code of Ordinances is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That this purchase is budgeted for FY 15-16.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
