On March 22, 2019, at 2335 hours, I (Officer Morris) was driving east on Eaton Street, in my marked Key West Police Department patrol vehicle, when I observed an Orange Dodge Caliber, bearing Florida plate LBRB52, traveling North on White Street. The vehicle failed to stop at a red light on White Street. The vehicle turned East onto Palm Ave. I activated my overhead lights and sirens and conducted a traffic stop.

I spoke with the driver, Shawn Meehan, who gave me his Florida Driver License and vehicle registration. I radioed for a backup officer. I asked KWPD Dispatch Communications Channel 2 (COMM2) to conduct a Wants and Warrants check on Shawn. COMM 2 informed me that Shawn's Florida Driver License was suspended on 03/11/2019.

K9 Officer T. Anglin, Sgt. Siracuse, Officer B. Tyler, and Officer Purcell arrived on scene.

We asked the driver (Shawn) and the passengers (Michael Mayle and Corianne Depoo Preater) to step out while Officer Anglin utilized his K9 Ben to conduct an exterior sniff of the vehicle for the odor of narcotics. Officer Anglin informed us that K9 Ben alerted to the vehicle. found a large camo backpack with a valid Florida Identification card belonging to Shawn. Sgt. Siracuse asked Shawn why his license was suspended, and he advised that he had been previously arrested and that suspending his license was part of a plea deal. We conducted a search of the vehicle and found a small blue pill in Depoo's purse. Using roadside identification system, we identified the pill as a Diazepam 10mg. Depoo stated that the purse was hers and we found her Florida Identification Card inside. We also found approximately 20 counterfeit \$20.00 in Depoo's purse.

Sgt. Siracuse had Mayle and Meehan sit on the sidewalk and Sgt. Siracuse brought Depoo and sat her in the rear of my patrol vehicle. Prior to sitting her inside the vehicle Sgt. Siracuse explained to her she was detained as a passenger under Florida state law (Presley V. State, PA V. Mimms). While Officers were searching the vehicle, Sgt. Siracuse returned to check on Depoo. Sgt. Siracuse found Depoo Facetiming on her cell phone. Sgt. Siracuse attempted to take Depoo's cell phone from her and told her to stay in the car. Depoo got out of the car, pulling the phone from Sgt. Siracuse's hand. Depoo continued to pull away from Sgt. Siracuse and he pressed her into the patrol vehicle. Depoo pulled away and tensed her arms as Ofc. Tyler and Sgt. Siracuse attempted to place her hands behind her back. Depoo continued to pull away and Sgt. Siracuse conducted an arm bar takedown and took her to the ground. Officer Tyler handcuffed Depoo once she was on the ground.

Search incident to arrest, Depoo removed a large amount of currency, approximately 50 counterfeit \$20.00 and actual currency, from her brazier.

Sgt. Siracuse explained to Depoo that she was being placed under arrest for resisting an officer without violence and for possession of a controlled substance.

I transported Depoo to the Monroe County Detention Center.

Officer Purcell placed Shawn under arrest and transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

Upon arrival to the detention center, I contacted poison control. I spoke with Canaan who identified the small round blue pill, with the markings TEVA on one side and 3927 on the other as Diazepam 10 mg. Canaan issued me case number T4885726.

Upon arrival to the detention center, I issued Shawn Criminal Traffic Citation #AAMZL1E for driving while license suspended with knowledge. Shawn was given a criminal court date of 04/04/2019 at 0900 hours with Judge Fowler. Shawn signed the citation agreeing to show up to court. I issued Shawn a warning for running the red light.

Under the Drug Abuse Prevention and Control standards and schedules, FL Statute 893.03 (4)(B)#20, Diazepam (generic brand name Xanax) is listed as a schedule IV controlled substance. Corianne Depoo did not have a prescription for the substance, therefore she was in violation of F.S.S. 893.13(6)(a), possession of a controlled substance without a valid prescription.

Officer Purcell placed the Diazepam and the counterfeit currency into KWPD property and evidence.

The incident was captured on my AXON BWC and in car COBAN.

Officer T. Anglin towed the vehicle from the scene.

Depoo has an extensive criminal history and is currently out on bond reference multiple narcotics violations.

On 22MAR19 at 2336, I (Ofc. T. ANGLIN) responded to the area of Palm Avenue and Ely Avenue, at the request of Ofc. C. MORRIS, who had conducted a traffic stop on an orange 2008 Dodge Caliber, (FL Tag# LBRB52) for violation of a traffic control device. Upon my arrival to the traffic stop, I approached the passenger's side of the stopped Dodge and immediately noticed that the front passenger, later identified by Officers as MICHAEL J MAYLE appeared to be very nervous as he was taking in extremely deep breaths while looking straight ahead. Ofc. C. MORRIS looked at me over the stopped Dodge and requested that I utilize K-9 BEN to conduct a K-9 sniff of the exterior of the stopped Dodge. I motioned for him to wait a moment as I gauged the behavior of the front passenger.

While I stood in place on the passenger's side, I also took note that MAYLE never once looked in my direction and then I diverted my attention to the back-seat passenger, (On the passenger's side of the vehicle) later identified by Officers on scene as CORRIANNE DEPOO-PREATER. I noticed the DEPOO-PREATER kept her hands on the rear portion of the front passenger's seat as well as maintaining a straight-ahead gaze. I took a step back and requested an additional Officer respond to the traffic stop in order to safely conduct a K-9 sniff of the exterior of the stopped Dodge.

Once Sgt. M. SIRACUSE, Ofc. C. PURCELL and Ofc. B. TYLER arrived on scene, they asked the occupants to step out of the stopped Dodge and take a seat on the bicycle path. Once the occupants were out of the stopped Dodge, I returned to my patrol vehicle and affixed my six-foot nylon lead onto the one-inch nylon collar K-9 BEN was wearing. I retrieved K-9 BEN from the rear of my patrol vehicle and approached the passenger's side front bumper on the stopped Dodge. I gave K-9 BEN the command to sniff for narcotics and moved counter clockwise around the exterior of the stopped Dodge.

I observed a noticeable change in K-9 BEN'S normal behavior as we approached the driver's door. K-9 BEN'S body became rigid and his respiratory effort increased as he scanned his nose along the face of the driver's door. K-9 BEN paused in front of the door, scanned his nose up towards the open window, took in several deep breaths and sat at the door. I gave K-9 BEN praise as well as his toy reward and secured him in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

I returned to the stopped Dodge and Ofc. B. TYLER, Ofc. C. MORRIS and I manually searched the interior of the vehicle. I observed trace amounts of what appeared to be a white powdery substance strewn about the interior of the stopped Dodge, (Driver's floor, center console cupholders, front passenger's seat and underneath the front passenger's seat). I utilized a Cocaine field test swab and began wiping the aforementioned areas. I observed a positive reaction for the presence of Cocaine, (F.T.P. Cocaine) on the swabs. I attempted to collect some of the Cocaine residue from the front passenger's seat, but was unsuccessful in gaining a viable sample.

On 3/22/19, at approximately 2330 hours, I (Sgt. M. Siracuse) responded to Palm Avenue, just east of White Street in reference to a traffic stop. Ofc. C. Morris and K9 Ofc. T. Anglin had pulled over an orange Dodge Caliber with three occupants. The driver, identified as Shawn Meehan, did not have a valid driver's license. Also, in the vehicle was Corianne Depoo and Michael Mayle. I recognized Depoo and Mayle from prior narcotics related complaints and incidents.

Ofc. B. Tyler and Ofc. C. Purcell arrived on scene as backup. I had the three occupants exit the vehicle. I had Mayle and Meehan sit on the sidewalk and I brought Depoo and sat her in the rear of Ofc. Morris' patrol vehicle. Prior to sitting her inside the vehicle I explained to her she was detained as a passenger under Florida state law (Presley V. State, PA V. Mimms). Ofc. Anglin utilized his K9 Ben and noted a positive alert to the vehicle. While Officers were searching the vehicle, I returned to check on Depoo. I found Depoo Facetiming on her cell phone. I attempted to take Depoo's cell phone from her and told her to stay in the car. Depoo got out of the car, pulling the phone from my hand. Depoo continued to pull away from me and I pressed her into the patrol vehicle. Depoo pulled away and tensed her arms as Ofc. Tyler and I attempted to place her hands behind her back. Depoo continued to pull away and I conducted an arm bar takedown and took her to the ground. Officer Tyler handcuffed Depoo once she was on the ground. Throughout the incident Depoo ignored our clear, loud, verbal commands.

Search incident to arrest, Depoo removed a large amount of currency, some counterfeit and some real, from her brazier. I told Depoo she was being arrested for resisting an officer without violence. Depoo said she didn't want us to look in her phone because she had naked pictures. I told Depoo we were just taking her phone for officer safety, not to go through it.

Depoo was subsequently arrested for possession of a controlled substance in addition to resisting. Meehan was arrested for driving without a valid DL and Mayle was released on scene. The vehicle was towed by Arnold's. Sgt. Rodriguez briefly responded to the scene reference a RRI.

I recorded this incident on my BWC.
