### Action Statement:

This resolution serves to approve the extension of the expiring interlocal agreement between the City of Key West and the Monroe County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) for shared use of the countywide 800 MHz radio system. This resolution also serves as an approval to pay the City's share of the pro-rata portion of the maintenance cost of \$20,337.48 for fiscal year 17-18.

### Background:

In City of Key West resolution 06-012 the City Commission approved an interlocal agreement between the City of Key West and the MCSO enabling the City to join a multi-agency platform in use of a countywide 800 MHz radio system.

With the aging of an outdated radio system and the addition of the Lower Keys Shuttle it became necessary for the City's DOT to be able to communicate beyond Key West and the MCSO offered a cost-effective way to accomplish that objective. Since, other City departments have also found it cost-effective and efficient to use the same radio system.

The most recent renewal has expired and the MCSO has offered to extend the agreement for another four (4) years through September 30, 2021. The acceptance of this renewal would be retroactive to October 1, 2017. If accepted, all terms of the agreement will remain status quo and funds have been budgeted and approved to pay for the related services.

**Justification:**

The MCSO 800 MHz radio system has proven to be cost effective and reliable. Any alternate radio system would require the purchase of system infrastructure creating a greater financial burden.

**Recommendation:**

With a reliable radio system already in place, it is recommended that the City Commission accept and approve the MCSO offer to extend the inter-local agreement through September 30, 2021.
