

ORDINANCE NO. 99-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 63 ENTITLED "TRAFFIC" BY AMENDING SECTION 63.1983 (a) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING THE AREA AFFECTED BY THE RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM TO EXPAND THE AREAS OF ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

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WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, finds that it is in the best interest of both the safety and convenience of residents in the entire downtown area of the City to expand the provisions of Section 63.1983 to designate residential parking spaces in areas previously not included in the residential parking permit program area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That "Exhibit A" of Section 63.1983 is hereby amended as attached. The residential parking permit program is expanded accordingly to include each block of the City in the area delineated in "Exhibit A".

Section 2: If any section, provision, clause, phrase, or application of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable therefrom and shall be construed as reasonable and necessary to achieve the lawful purposes of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances of said City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.


Section 4: This Ordinance shall go into effect thirty (30) after its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

EXHIBIT A

District 6

Residential Parking Program Block by Block Allocation

- ◆ Ashe Street from Southard Street to Truman Avenue.
- ◆ Truman Avenue from Frances Street to Windsor Lane.
- ◆ Windsor Lane from Truman Avenue to Amelia Street.
- ◆ Amelia Street from Windsor Lane to Simonton Street.
- ◆ Simonton Street from Amelia Street to United Street.
- ◆ United Street through U. S. Naval Reservation, including the Outermole.
- ◆ Southard Street from Ashe Street to Thomas Street.

The above streets are district boundary streets. Streets for residential parking within their district are:

- ◆ Southard Street from Duval Street to Thomas Street. (Southard Street has previously been restriped from White Street to Duval Street)
- ◆ Frances Street from Southard Street to Truman Avenue.
- ◆ Angela Street from Emma Street to Windsor Lane.
- ◆ Windsor Lane to Passover Lane.
- ◆ Passover Lane to Angela Street.
- ◆ Windsor Lane from Passover Lane to Amelia Street.
- ◆ Margaret Street from Southard Street to Angela Street.
- ◆ Grinnell Street from Southard Street to Angela Street.
- ◆ Olivia Street from Fort Street to Frances Street.
- ◆ William Street from Southard Street to Windsor Lane.
- ◆ Elizabeth Street from Southard Street to Truman Avenue.
- ◆ Simonton Street from Southard Street to United Street, including Olivia & Petronia
- ◆ Duval Street from Southard Street to United Street,
- ◆ Whitehead Street from Southard Street to United Street, including Olivia & Petronia
- ◆ Thomas Street from Southard Street to Catherine Street.
- ◆ Emma Street from Angela Street to Amelia Street.
- ◆ Fort Street from Petronia Street to Amelia Street.
- ◆ Catherine Street from Howe Street to Simonton Street.
- ◆ Louisa Street from Simonton Street to Duval Street.
- ◆ Amelia Street from Fort Street to Duval Street.
- ◆ Virginia Street from Emma Street to Simonton Street.

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- ◆ Julia Street from Emma Street to Duval Street.
 - ◆ Petronia Street from Fort Street to Thomas Street.
 - ◆ Petronia Street from Duval Street to Elizabeth Street.
 - ◆ Angela Street from Whitehead Street to Elizabeth Street.
 - ◆ Center Street

Note: Streets with parking meters installed are not eligible for the Residential Parking Program (RP). Parking passes can be obtained. Streets that are too narrow for parking will be excluded.

DISTRICT 5

- White Street from Truman Avenue to Olivia Street.
- United Street from Simonton Street to William Street.
- 1100 Block of Grinnell Street.

Note: Streets with parking meters installed are not eligible for the Residential Parking Program (RP). Parking passes can be obtained. Streets that are too narrow for parking will be excluded.
